I Sri Sudarshan Roy of Meja PS do hereby lodge complaint Suomoto against (i) Vidya Sagar son of Lt Modan Mohan Das of Kumerbari, Ranigumpha PS - Ranigumpha Dist West Bardhaman and (ii) Samir Tewary S/o Lt R. S. Tewary of Millan Pally, Amrai Burghapur Dist West Bardhaman and others and brought 10 (Ten) quintal coal along with 02 nos. Basket and 03 nos. Spade under proper seizure as per seizure list and do hereby state that the effect that today on 18.07.17 at 09.35 hrs held raid at Bhului near els shop against transportation / dealing of stolen coal habitually / professionally procuring the coal by extracting from illegal pits of Bhului and Ardhaagram side. On arrival a BLTP team i.e. Sri partha Pratham Roy Joint BAO Meja (ii) Sri Anil Das BLTP LRO Meja (iii) Mir Alam Hossain Govt Amin (iv) Sri Asoke Pal RO of BLTP Meja (v) C 895 - Bablu Ch. Mandal (vi) Mr. Anil Mahata It could be noticed that there are one unauthorised coal depot of Bhului near els shop and the sign and existence of stocking clandestine dealing of stolen coal on that depot were also noticed. In between 09.35 hrs to 10.25 hrs held raid against the unauthorised coal depot but nobody available there. About 10 (Ten) quintal of coal was found stocked in coal depot. So it is every reason to believe that above noted accused persons procure the coal by extracting from illegal pits of Bhului and Ardhaagram side to run the clandestine business of stolen coal habitually and professionally for their wrong full gain from coal depot. As such I seized the stock of coal weighting about 10 (Ten) quintal from the coal depot, 02 nos Basket and 03 nos of Spade under proper seizure list in between 09.45 hrs and 10.25 hrs. I also arranged for its shifting to PS.

During local enquiry it further revealed that the above noted accused persons are habitually and professionally transporting / dealing stolen coal for sale elsewhere after procurement the same by extracting from illegal pits of Bhului making criminal conspiracy with receiver of such coal for their wrong full gain and as such the accused persons committed punishable offence.

On my return to PS I started a case against (i) Vidya Sagar son of Lt Modan Mohan Das of Kumerbari, Ranigumpha PS - Ranigumpha Dist West Bardhaman (ii) Samir Tewary S/o Lt R. S. Tewary of Millan Pally, Amrai Burghapur Dist West Bardhaman side and (iii) mines and minerals (development & regulation) Act - 1957, and endorse to Sr. Ujjal Singh to investigate the case.
