Sub: Prayer For Starting A Specific Case Under Proper Section Of Law.

Sir,

I, A.S.I. Nandalal Mandal of Onda PS beg to submit that today i.e. on 26/07/2017 at about 11:00 hrs, while myself along with force were performing MV checking duty at Onda Bazar Area (vide GDE No- 886 and C.C. No- 2812/17 dtd. 26/07/2017), suddenly I heard hue and cry of people and came to learn that a R.T.A. has took place near Onda Boy's School Morh. Accordingly, I rushed to the spot and immediately shifted the injured persons to BSMC&H, Bankura for their proper medical treatment. In the mean time, about 150-200 people started gathering on the spot and attempted to damage the offending truck bearing no- AP 37 TB/6799. I along with my accompanying force tried to convince the mob but they were so much unruly that they did not pay any heed to our words and obstructed Police to take the offending truck in our safe custody. The mob started hurling filthy abusive languages to Police and alleged that the accident took place as Civic Volunteers are used for traffic control and Police is also harassing local people by continuous Motor-cycle checking and other allied issues. They tried to enter inside Onda PS compound forcefully but somehow they could be stopped at the main gate of PS. Being unsuccessful, the mob gathered just in front of the main gate of Onda PS and started showing protest against Police by sitting on the National Highway-60 road in a negligent manner and caused road-blockade using traffic guardrails and drums and thereby obstructed the total road transportation by making NH-60 road impassable. I informed the matter to OC Onda PS and other officers over mobile phone and they immediately reached the spot and all tried to convince the mob continuously but they flatly denied to accept any words from Police and continued their road blockade. Instead of repeated commands by Police, the Mob continued road blocked. This whole dismal situation continued for about 1.5 hours. Finding no other alternatives and to clear up the road blockade for the interest of travelling and transportation of goods and general public, necessary force was used to disperse the unlawful mob and they fled away from the spot. Thereafter with assistance of other officers and force, we shifted the traffic guardrails and drums and there by peace and tranquility was restored in the locality. In consultation with other officers, force and sources, I became ascertained about the identity and involvement of the following Fourteen (14) accused persons namely (1) Gourav Bhattacharjee, S/o Rabindranath Bhattacharjee of Vill- Onda, (2) Mangal Batabyal, S/o Shibdas Batabyal of Vill- Chandrakona, (3) Bidyut Roy, S/o Bhaskar Roy of Vill- Fulberia, (4) Buddhadeb Roy, S/o Lt. Sarat Roy of Vill- Damodarhati, (5) Anup Kr. Ganguli @Dolan, S/o Santiram Ganguli of Vill- Khamarberia, (6) Dipak Katari, S/o Bahu Katari of Vill- Khamarberia, (7) Sukumar Garai, S/o Debdas Garai of Vill- Onda Station Road, (8) Chiranjit Biswas, S/o Asok Biswas of Vill- Onda near football ground, (9) Soumen De@Somu, S/o Robilochan De of Vill- Kumardanga, (10) Asok Mishra, S/o Lt. Arun Prabha Mishra of Vill- Onda Mishrapara, (11) Monoj Mishra, S/o Abani Mishra of Vill- Onda Mishrapara, (12) Anup Debghoria, S/o Lt. Debdas Debgharia of Vill- Onda Cinema Road, (13) Pranab De, S/o Lt. Under the above facts and circumstance, I pray before your kind self that a specific case may kindly be started against the above noted accd. persons under proper section of law and arrange for its investigation.
