Subject: Complaint of intimidation, misbehaviour & theft against Santanu Pratihhar

Sir,

This is to inform you that Shri Santanu Pratihhar, S/O- Gopal Chandra Pratihhar of Village Magura, Post Office Magura, District- Bankura entered into my office chamber at about 4.21 PM today. He verbally threatened me with dire consequences if I do not provide him with a license to carry on business at Ragunath Rice Mill, Magura. After some time Shrimati Baisakhi Das, Nirman Sahayak of Gelia Gram Panchayat entered my chamber and sat beside him. He, without any provocation, misbehaved with Shrimati Das and caught her hand. He also picked up and stole an expensive pair of sunglasses owned by Shri Prabir Kumar Shit, the Joint Block Development Officer, Joypur which was lying on my table. I also attach the CCTV footage showing his misconduct.

I request you to please look into the matter and take appropriate action.
