Sir,

In producing here with the accused namely 1) Bhairab Ruidas (42 yrs) S/O- Lt. Nimai Ruidas of Vill- Patrai Ruidas Para, 2. Ram Ruidas (33 yrs) S/O Gopal Ruidas of Vill- Bajitpur both of PS- Indas Dist - Bankura with seized ID liquor amounting about 10 liters in a Jar under Seizure and I beg to submit that today (02.08.17) while myself SI Ranjit Kumar Mondal along with force were engaged in evening patrolling duty in PS area. At about 19:30 hrs received a secret source information that some person selling ID liquor at Village Patrai in an open place. To acting secret source information I informed to O/C Indas PS over telephone and I along with force had been to Patrai Village and found some persons assembled in front of chicken shop in the name of Bhairab Ruidas of vill- Bajitpur, P.S- Indas, Dist- Bankura. I along with force held raid and able to apprehend two persons noted above, many of them succeed to flee away from the spot. On being search found that plastic jar containing about 10 liters of colorless liquid having strong smell of ID liquor. On being asked they did not having any document in respect of selling of liquor. Over this circumstances it was clear that the above accused persons were selling liquors to the persons & stocking liquors with a view to wrongful gain by losing huge revenue of the Govt. accordingly I seized the following articles in a proper seizure list duly signed by the accused persons and local witnesses from 20:15 to 20:45 hrs .So that they are liable to be prosecuted U/S 46A(a) of B.E Act. As they were found selling liquors openly and caught red handed, so I arrested them by maintaining all the formalities, and producing this PS . .

Seized articles:

- 1) One plastic jar containing about 10 liters of liquor having strong smell of ID liquor. 2. About 500 ML. I/D taken out from aforesaid jar as a sample file duly sealed and labeled by me.

Under the above fact and circumstances I pray that a case may kindly be registered against above arrested accused persons for further investigation.
