**Sub: Lodging an FIR in connection with misappropriation of PDS Commodities by Fair Price Shop Dealer, Khetra Gopal Dutta.**

Sir,

I would like to bring the following facts to your kind notice.

1. Huge irregularities have been found during the hour of inspection at the Fair Price Shop of Khetra Gopal Dutta, Village- Bhutsahar, P.O. Sanbandha, Block- Bankura-II on 05.09.2017.
2. 18.39 quintal Wheat , 23.88 quantal Rice, 13.50 quintal fortified Atta, was allocated for the first fortnight of September 2017 by the undersigned.
3. During inspection the dealer could not produce any sales registers, cash memos , stock register to the undersigned on demand.
4. During physical verification process of the stock present on the Godown of FPS Dealer following stock were found Wheat 3.5 quintal, Rice 14.95 quintals, and Fortified Atta 13.50 quintals.
5. This is evident from the aforesaid stock verification, that there was a discrepancy of 14.89 quintal of wheat in his godown.

Whereas on 04.09.2017 at 11.40 a.m. as per the petition of villagers of Bhutsahar of Bankura-II Block that they caught Sri Khetrageopal Dutta red handed while he was transferring the stock to one Sri Somnath Dutta ,owner of a atta chaki mill of Bhutsahar . And on subsequent raid by Sub-Inspector, Food & Supplies In Charge of Bankura-II accompanied with three police personnel of Bankura Police Station found and seized 11 quintals wheat out of which 5.5 quintals was FCI marked on the gunny (that is used for PDS).

Kindly treat as First Information Report as per provision of Essential Commodities Act, 1955. Under Section 3 and 7.
