Sir,

In producing here with one Sumi Murmu (40 Yrs) W/O-Lt. Jagannath of Vill- Talbandi, PS – Onda, Dist. – Bankura along with seized articles (1) One pipe fitted Funnel, (2) One clay Pot with lid, (3) One White 5 liters Jariken containing approx 5 liters *Cholai*, (4) One bottle containing approx 600 ml of ID liquor collected as sample from Sl. No.(3), (5) One Tin containing approx 7/8 Kg of Molasses, I, ASI Arun Betal of Onda PS do hereby lodge complaint against Sumi Murmu (40 Yrs) W/O-Lt. Jagannath of Vill- Talbandi, PS – Onda, Dist. – Bankura to the effect that on 06.09.17 at about 05.15 hrs duty officer of Onda PS SI Himangshu Sekhar Singha received a source information about illegal selling of liquor going on at village Talbandi under Onda PS in the house of Sumi Murmu. Accordingly as per information of duty officer I along with force and lady constable went to Talbandi village to work out the information vide Onda PS GDE No. 218 dtd. 06.09.17.

On 06.09.17 at about 06.05 hrs, I along with force and lady constable reached at Talbandi and met with my source and he guided us to the house of Sumi Murmu where she run his business of ID liquor. I left my vehicle in a certain distance and quickly moved towards her house. Seeing the police in uniform, some persons who were sitting in the court yard of her house, rushed from the spot. On suspicion, I chased them with the help of my force but all of them managed to escape except one of them. I interrogated her and during interrogation, she confessed that her name is Sumi Murmu and she confessed that she is manufacturing and selling ID liquor from her house since long.

Accordingly, I along with my force in presence of local people searched the house of Sumi Murmu thoroughly maintaining the rules & regulations and found (1) One pipe fitted Funnel, (2) One clay Pot with lid, (3) One White 5 liters Jariken containing approx 5 liters *Cholai*, (4) One Tin containing approx 10/12 KG of Molasses from his room. From local witnesses, I also came to learn that she was manufacturing and selling liquor illegally from that place since long. On demand neither she nor anyone in favour of her, could produce any license or any valid document for selling of Liquor. I arranged to collect sample from the above noted articles and seized, sealed and labeled the same in between 06.35 hrs to 07.05 hrs and acquired her signature on seizure list and label. I requested local available witnesses to sign the seizure list and label as seizure witness, but no public witness came forward. So, police witnesses signed the seizure list and label as seizure witness. Then I arrested her with maintaining rules & regulation of arrest.

Under the above circumstances, I request you to start a specific case against the above noted accused person namely Sumi Murmu of do under proper section of law and arrange for its investigation.
