In producing here with seized 51 (fifty one) nos of plastic bags of ammonium nitrate containing each 50 kg, each on which it is written OPTIMEX-PLUS. LOW DENSITY POROUS PRILLED AMMONIUM NITRATE, MANUFACTURED IN INDIA BY SMARTCHEM TECHNOLOGIES LIMITED ,PLOTS K1-K5& K8 ,MIDC Industrial Area ,Taloja A.V. 410 208 Dist. Raigad Maharastra ,India and do hereby lodged complaint against one Shyamali Mandal w/o Swapan Mandal of Saltora PS-Saltora, Dist. Bankura and her accomplices/abettors to the effect that on 21.09.17 received an information at PS (This refers to Saltora GDE No.738 dated-21.09.17) through phone that one vehicle was unloading some explosive material at a abandoned house, on the Dhatala-Kanuri pitch road under Saltora PS . Accordingly myself along with ASI Biswajit Banerjee along with C/855 Umapada Mandal ,C/320 Bibhuti Majhi and NVF/796 Ashok Mahato all of Saltora PS had been to there to work out the information. At around 14:45 hrs we reached there and cordoned the place, then we reached at the abandoned house and found that the door of an abandoned room magazine was opened and nobody present there .We entered the room and found that 51 (fifty one) nos of plastic bags of ammonium nitrate containing each 50 kg each on which it is written OPTIMEX-PLUS. LOW DENSITY POROUS PRILLED AMMONIUM NITRATE,MANUFACTURED IN INDIA BY SMARTCHEM TECHNOLOGIES LIMITED,PLOTS K1-K5& K8 ,MIDC Industrial Area ,Taloja A.V. 410 208 Dist. Raigad Maharastra ,India . I searched the said room as well as beside the room but no one found there . The ammonium nitrate is an oxidizer and it is used for making high explosives(ANFO) to endanger lives and property . On local enquiry we examined two passers by namely Uttam Mandal s/o Subodh Mandal of Dhatala PS-Saltora dist-Bankura and Nilmadhab Majhi s/o Sudhir Majhi of Ledapalash PS-Saltora Dist-Bankura and informed that one Shyamali Mandal w/o Swapan Mandal of Saltora PS-Saltora,Dist. Bankura was the registered licence owner of the said abandoned room which was used as magazine for keeping explosive substance legally but at present she did not renew her licence. So finding no other alternative I seized those 51(fifty one) nos of plastic bag of ammonium nitrate as per seizure list in presence of witnesses and properly labeled. On return we had been to house of said Shyamali Mandal at saltora and found that she and her family members was found absent in that house . On interrogation to the local people it was learnt that as soon as police party arrived in the village said Shyamali Mandal and her family members fled away to evade police arrest keeping their house abandoned under lock and key . So It is highly believed that those explosive substance which were to be used for making explosives were brought illegally ,stocked there without having any valid licence with a view to transport any other places for any illegal purpose and thereby she along with her accomplices/abettors are liable for prosecution u/s 5/6 of Explosive substance Act 1808. Accordingly I registered a case vide Saltora PS case no- 62/17 dt 21.09.17 u/s 5/6 Explosive substance Act 1808 against Shyamali Mandal w/o Swapan Mandal of Saltora PS-Saltora,Dist. Bankura and her accomplices/abettors and endorsed to SI Surajit Paul for its investigation . On return to PS I typed the complaint in our office computer .
