Sir,

With due respect and humble submission I ASI Chinta Haran Gorai beg to submit that as per your order on 17.12.16 I along with C/795 Murali Mohan Ata went to inquest the dead body of Malayendu Barik (40yrs) s/o Lt Santosh Barik of Karakanali, PS Simlupal, Dist Bankura in c/w Simlupal PS UD case no-19/16 dated 17.12.16 at Jungle area beside a canal of west side of the village Karakanali under Simlupal PS. In presence of witnesses after inquest I sent the body with the help of C/795 Murali Mohan Ata for PM examination at Bankura Police Morgue with all relevant papers to ascertain the actual cause of death. I also made local enquiry but no any foul play could be found regarding this death. I received the PM report of above noted UD case and found that Dr. Tanay Mohanta, Asst. Professor of D.F.M, BSMC&H, Bankura opined 'Death was due to the effects of ante mortem injuries and Homicidal in manner, further opinion, if any may be given after receipt of CE's reports.'

Under the circumstances I requested you to go through the original P.M report and to start a specific case and arrange for its investigation.

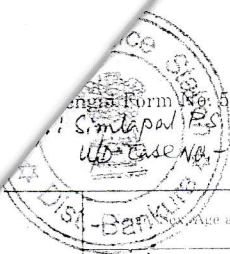
