I, SI Supriya Banerjee of Gangajalghati P.S., Bankura do hereby lodged a written complain to the effect that on 19.12.17 at about 12.35 hrs, O/C Gangajalghati PS received a secret source information to the effect that one person carrying some ganja in a bicycle by his possession and would be coming from Durlavpur side through Durlavpur - Gangajalghati (NH 60) road for selling the same to someone in lieu of money somewhere near Deuli more. Accordingly O/C Gangajalghati PS diarized the information vide G.Ghati P.S. GDE no - 736 dated 19.12.17 and instructed me and S.I Prafullya Kumar Mahapatra of Gangajalghati PS who was detailed for mobile duty to Carry out the information as I was detailed for Naka duty vide Gangajalghati PS CC No-3359/17 dt 19.12.17. Accordingly, I along with SI Prafulla Kumar Mahapatra, C/491 Madhusudan Mahata & C/348 Dinesh Akuli left for Deuli More.

At 13.05 hrs we arrived near Deuli more and called three available pedestrian and briefed them about our information and requested them to accompany us as witnesses. They readily agreed on our proposal and disclosed their identities as 1) Rajib Tewary S/O- Lt. Adhir Kumar Tewary of

Vill + PO + PS - G.Ghati Dist Bankura. 2) Samiran Gorakshi S/O - Anil Gorakshi of Vill + PO +PS - G.Ghati Dist Bankura. 3) Tulsi Gorakshi s/o - Biswanath Gorakshi of Vill+ PO +PS - G.Ghati Dist Bankura. We proceeded towards the spot and took the source on the way and kept our vehicle at about 100 meter away towards Gangajalghati side from Deuli More in the deep Jungle and ambushed at Deuli More by covering all the three side.

At 13.15 hrs we found that one person was coming from Durlavpur side on a By-cycle in which he was carrying a white colour polythene gunny bag on back side carrier of his By-Cycle. Accordingly as per source identification, we intercepted that person with his By-Cycle. We disclosed our identity as police personnel before him and on being asked he disclosed his identity as Sk. Abdul Gaffar (31yrs), s/o- Sk. Abdul Kader of vill - Vedua ( Kala Para) PO - Uttarbil PS - Garhbeta Dist - Paschim Medinipur. I told him that I have definite information that he is carrying Ganja on his By-Cycle and on thorough interrogation he also confessed that he possessed the ganja with him in that white colour bag which he was carrying in his Hero By-Cycle for selling the same as per prior agreement. Then we detained the said person to wait for his proper search and also requested the local witnesses to accompany him and at 13.25 hrs I informed O/C Gangajalghati P.S over mobile phone regarding the fact and requested him to arrange for a Executive Magistrate, if possible for conducting\* search at the spot and also requested to carry with him the necessary articles like white paper, carbon paper, brown paper, pen, pencil, seal, stamp pad, sealing wax (Gala), metal specimen seal, candle, match box, electronics weighing machine etc. At 13.40 hrs S.I Supriyo Ranjan Maji, O/C Gangajalghati PS being accompanied by Sri Partha Sarathi Chakroborty, CI Gangajalghati Circle being a Gazetted Police officer arrived at the spot with all necessary articles, as no executive magistrate or any other gazetted officer available at this time as stated by O/C Gangajalghati PS and they disclosed their identity before the detained person. Then Sri Partha Sarathi Chakroborty, CI Gangajalghati Circle, served a written notice upon him to know whether he wanted to be searched by any Magistrate or any Gazetted officer as per provision of law and he replied in writing that he has no objection in either. I offered to search our persons by witnesses and

Gazetted officer but he in reply denied searching of our persons. Then as per order and presence of CI Gangajalghati Circle and as well as in the presence of above noted witnesses I searched the person and his belongings and recovered one white colour polythene gunny bag containing ganja from his intercepted Hero Bicycle. As per order of CI Gangajalghati Circle, I took the weight of the said white colour gunny bag through electronics weighing machine and found total weight of the bag is 20Kg 500gms. As per order of CI Gangajalghati circle accd Sk Abdul Gaffar himself opened the gunny bag in presence of the witnesses and at once received smell of Ganja and once again said accd confessed that he possessed this Ganja to sell the same as per his agreement. Then in presence of above witnesses and as per order of CI Gangajalghati Circle I seized the following articles under proper seizure list from the exclusive possession of Sk. Abdul Gaffar (31yrs),s/o- Sk. Abdul Kader of vill - Vedua ( Kala Para) PO - Uttarbil PS - Garhbeta Dist - Paschim Medinipur.

**Seized Articles:-**

1. One white colour polythene gunny bag in which "TATA SALT" inscribed in one side and containing (seems to be ) 20 kgs 500gms ganja.
2. One Green colored "HERO" Bicycle fitted with a back carrier.
3. One yellow color Nylon rope of 17 ft 9 inch.

I Packed, sealed and labeled all the seized articles. Seizure was made on 19/12/2017 in between 14.15 hrs hrs and 14.55 hrs. The detained Sk. Abdul Gaffar (31yrs),s/o- Sk. Abdul Kader of vill - Vedua ( Kala Para) PO - Uttarbil PS - Garhbeta Dist - Paschim Medinipur, admitted that he was going through that spot with the said recovered gunny bag of ganja by the above seized Bicycle for selling the same to other persons in exchange of money. Being asked he failed to produce any license or documents in respect of the said ganja and the Bicycle. Hence as per order of CI Gangajalghati Circle. I arrested the accused person at 15.25 hrs for possessing ganja illegally. I also interrogated him thoroughly regarding his other associates but he kept his mouth mum. Supplied copy of memo of arrest, seizure list etc to the arrested person.

Under the above circumstances, a case u/s 20 (b)(ii)(c) NDPS Act 1985 as amended in 2001 against the above noted accused namely Sk. Abdul Gaffar (31yrs),s/o- Sk. Abdul Kader of vill – Vedua ( Kala Para) PO – Uttarbil PS – Garhbeta Dist – Paschim Medinipur, may kindly be started and arrangement may kindly be done for its investigation for the sake of justice.
