Sub: - Complaint

Respect Sir,

In producing here with the following seized items i) Some burnt thread made of jute giving off the scent of Exploded Bombs ii) Some Iron Balls giving off the smell of explosive iii) Some Stones giving off the smell of explosive and do here by lodge a complaint and sue-Moto against 125/140 unknown miscreants to the effect that today 31.12.17 at 10.15 hrs received an information from Duty officer of Indas PS that 02 groups of miscreants each group comprising 60/70 miscreants being armed with deadly weapons like lathi, iron rod, like bomb have gathered at Rol, football ground and Rol, Hat-tola. Over the issue of organizing a traditional fair at Rol, football ground and a breach of law & order as well as peace is most likely if not intervened by Police. Accordingly diaries the information vide GDE no.1145 Date -31.12.17 of Indas PS. Informed CI, and SDPO (V) over phone and requested to send reinforcement.

At 10.30 hrs myself with ASI Lakmi Kanta Mahapatra, ASI Suresh Mahadani and available force left for Rol, Bazaar (Vide GDE no.1146 dt-31.12.17 and C.C no-2697/17 Dt-31.12.17) and arrived at Rol Bazaar at about 10.55 hrs. and found a group of miscreants comprising 60/70 unknown persons have gathered being armed with lathi, bomb etc, and a few meter away another group comprising 60/70 persons have gathered at Rol, Hat-tola. All of them were equipped with deadly weapons, bombs etc and they were provoking each other's and threatening to kill each other, suddenly at about 11.15 hrs both the groups started hurling bombs aiming at each other and Police persons present there. The terror created by the miscreants was so heavy that all the shops got shut-down, people stated running to and fro to save the lives. I declared the assembly as unlawful and asked them to disperse but they did not disperse in order to save the lives of the people and police, myself with force resorted to mild lathi-charge and the miscreant got dispersed. Searching the area no injured person could be found but the seized items as noted above was found near a Pharmacy shop namely "Lakhan Pharmacy" situated beside the pitch road at Rol, Hat-tola. Accordingly at 12.15 hrs, I have seized aforesaid items under a memo of seizure duly attested by the witnesses.

Hence I pray an FIR may kindly be lodged for its regular investigation u/s -147/148/149/307/506 IPC read with section 3 & 4 Explosive Act.
