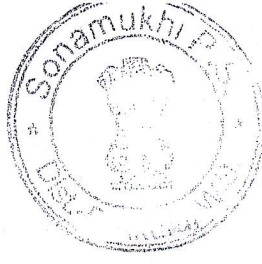

Sub:- Prayer for lodging a case against the accd. namely Bahadur Ankure (30 yrs) s/o- Lt Haradhan Ankure of Vill.- Chaitanyapur, PO- Radhamohanpur, PS Sonamukhi, Dist. Bankura for illegally selling of Id liquor.

Sir,

In producing herewith one arrested accd. namely Bahadur Ankure (30 yrs) s/o- Lt Haradhan Ankure of Vill.- Chaitanyapur, PO- Radhamohanpur, PS Sonamukhi, Dist. Bankura with seized articles namely 1) Two container each containing 20 lts of Id liquor alongwith samples from each container and (2) 15 pieces of plastic glasses all packed, sealed and labeled I SI Satyajit Mahanty, presently posted to Sonamukhi PS, do hereby lodge a complaint against Bahadur Ankure (30 yrs) s/o- Lt Haradhan Ankure of Vill.- Chaitanyapur, PO- Radhamohanpur, PS Sonamukhi, Dist. Bankura to the effect that on 21.02.18 at 16:45 hrs during my special raid duty along with C/715 Sukanta Murmu, NVF Prosenjit Singha and NVF Shibaprasad Maity received an information from my source that one Bahadur Ankure (30 yrs) s/o- Lt Haradhan Ankure of Vill.- Chaitanyapur, PO- Radhamohanpur, PS Sonamukhi, Dist. Bankura is illegally selling Id liquor in his house. Accordingly informed the matter to O/C, Sonamukhi PS. Myself alongwith force left PS to work out the information vide Sonamukhi PS GDE no. 963 dtd. 21.02.18. At about 17:35 hrs myself alongwith force reached the spot as noted above and found that the above noted accd. person is engaged in selling Id liquor in his house. We in uniform introducing ourselves and On demand the person could not produce any valid documents in respect of said id liquor. And requested him to his accountability regarding selling of Id. He didn't pay heed to our words and continued his illegal activity as if nothing can stop him. We warned him several times but he kept his ears deaf. To prevent him from committing further offence I arrested him as per the procedure laid down in CrPC and followed the latest guidelines of the Apex Court and seized the above noted articles from his possession under proper seizure duly signed by the witnesses. Though the public witnesses witnessed the seizure they denied to

put their signature on seizure list as they feared assault by the accd. person due to his being dangerous and desperate in nature. I packed, sealed and Labeled the seized articles at the spot. On local enquiry it came to light that he sell Id liquor in his house. As such Bahadur Ankure (30 yrs) s/o- Lt Haradhan Ankure of Vill.- Chaitanyapur, PO- Radhamohanpur, PS Sonamukhi, Dist. Bankura is liable to be punished under proper section of law.

Therefore I pray that a necessary arrangement be made for recording a specific case against the accd. Bahadur Ankure (30 yrs) s/o- Lt Haradhan Ankure of Vill.- Chaitanyapur, PO- Radhamohanpur, PS Sonamukhi, Dist. Bankura under proper section of law and for investigation of the same.
