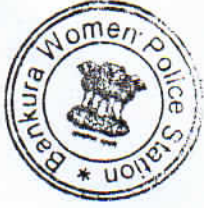

2. That after marriage the complainant went to her matrimonial home and stayed with the accused persons who all live in joint mess.
3. That at the time of marriage cash amount along with other precious gift items were given as per the demand of the accused persons.
4. That after some days of our marriage there was demand of more money from the accused persons.
5. That due to non payment of money the accused persons started inflicting physical and mental torture upon the complainant .
6. That complainant had lodged an F.I.R. before the Bankura P.S. which was registered as Bankura P.S.221/10 dated 2.09.10 which was charge sheeted and trial was started in Ld. J.M.5th court , Bankura .At the time of trial the husband and in-law's promised the complainant not to torture upon her and so the matter was compromised and Ld. court had been pleased to acquit all the accused persons.
7. That two female children namely Tandrayee (13 years) and Tamanna (5 years) were born out of their wedlock.
8. That after the Compromise again the accused persons started inflicting physical and mental torture upon the complainant for demand of dowry.

- IX. That the husband of the complainant is a habitual drunker . Almost everyday he used to assault the complainant , used very filthy language in front of their two daughters, one other accused encarraged him to do so.
- X. That the complainant tolerated all these tortures for a hope of continuing family life and the life of the two minor child.
- XI. That on 27.08.18 the torture crossed all limits .At about 11.30 P.M. when the complainant was in bed with her two child the accused no.1 came with full drunken condition and abused the complainant and severally assaulted the complainant in front of their two children.Somewhat the complainant saved her and her two children on that night.
- XII. That on the next day i.e. on 28.08.18 then complainant along with her two child in the very morning with one cloth came from her in-laws house and took shelter at her paternal house.
- XIII. That the complainant on the same day lodged an F.I.R. before Bankura Women P.S. but unfortunated it was only registered as G.D.E.No.612/18 very surprisingly the O.C. Women P.S. has received original complain and gave it back to the complainant.
- XIV. That on 28.9.18 the complainant submitted a petition

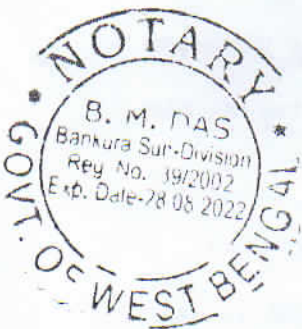
