I along with SI Atanu Kanjilal O/C Patrasayer PS SI Dinabandhu Ray and force held raids as per identification of plot by BL & LRO Patrasayer against illegal extraction of sand by illegal mining from Damodar river bed at Shalkhara Mouza. Far from a distance we found that illegal extraction/ mining of sand is going on. On seeing us all the unknown miscreants fled away leaving the tracks, pay loaders and others apparatus.
