Sir,

In producing here with the accused namely Rajat Ruidas (24 yrs.) S/O-Rabi Ruidas of vill- Fatepur PS- Indas Dist - Bankura with seized ID liquor amounting about 20 liters in two (02) white colour Jeri can (10 (Ten) ltr approx ID liquor (Chullu) in each Jeri can) under Seizure and I beg to submit that today (25.07.19) 19.05 hrs. arrived at Fatepur village and a raid was conducted in the house of Rajat Ruidas (24 yrs.) S/O-Rabi Ruidas of vill- Fatepur PS- Indas Dist - Bankura acting on secret source information against illegal stock and selling of liquor and on search found two (02) white colour Jeri can containing 10 (Ten) ltr approx ID liquor (Chullu) in each Jeri can having strong smell of ID liquor were kept with his possession in his house. On demand, he failed to produce any valid document from competent authority in respect of stocking & selling of said ID liquor. As such I seized two (02) number of white colour Jeri can containing 10 ltrs. ID liquor approx (Chullu) in each Jeri can under proper seizure list duly signed by the witness from 19.45 to 20:15 hrs. Approx 600 ml. ID liquor (Chullu) taken out as sample from both Jeri can and seized articles were labeled properly in presences of witness and arrested the above noted accused person after maintaining all the guidelines of Appex Court laid down in Cr.P.C.

The above noted arrested accused person namely, Rajat Ruidas (24 yrs.) S/O-Rabi Ruidas of vill- Fatepur PS- Indas Dist - Bankura committed an offence U/S- 46 A B.E. Act. 1909 for unauthorized possession and selling of Id Liquor (Chullu) from his sole possession in his own house.

Under the fact and circumstances, I therefore pray before you a specific Case may kindly be started against the said accused person under proper section of law and obliged.
