In the afternoon of 22/09/19 at 22.05h, I received a telephone call from Mr. Dinesh Kumar Das, a resident of Patrasayar, Bankura, who informed me that his wife, Mrs. Sunita Das, was missing. He stated that he had been unable to locate her since early morning. He requested that I assist him in finding her. I directed him to file a formal complaint at the police station. He agreed and left.

On arrival at the station, I found that Mr. Dinesh Kumar Das had already filed a complaint. I registered it under section 42 of the Indian Penal Code, 1950, and assigned it to a constable for investigation. I advised him to keep calm and not to panic. I also assured him that we would do our best to find his wife.

After registering the complaint, I spoke with Mr. Dinesh Kumar Das again to gather more information. He informed me that his wife had been missing since early morning. He had tried calling her but could not reach her. He also mentioned that she had been working as a domestic help in a nearby town and had not returned home. He had checked with his employer, but no one had seen her.

I advised Mr. Dinesh Kumar Das to file a missing person report with the concerned authorities. I also suggested that he should inform his employer about his wife's disappearance. I assured him that we would do our best to find her.

Mr. Dinesh Kumar Das thanked me for my assistance and left. I instructed the constable to follow up on the case and keep me updated.
