Sub: Report on money theft.

Respected Sir/Madam,

I, Lopamudra Mahapatra, w/o Sukumar Mahapatra, is a resident of vill: Majdihe, P.S - Onda. I am a woman entrepreneur. I am an Indian Oil Corporation dealer, since 2012. My bank is state Bank of India, Bankura, 25 km away from the location of my petrol pump (vill: Majdihe, P.S - Onda).

Since the start of the business, my staff Debinandan Mukherjee, has been carrying money to be deposited in bank. He has earned respect and trust from us through his service over the years. Debinandan Mukherjee, son of late Bhavanicharan Mukherjee, is a resident of vill: Majdihe P.S - Onda.

On 18/10/19, my staff Debinandan was on his way to bank when his bag was sliced, and note bundles were stolen. Total amount that he was carrying is Rs 5,25,500/- (Rs Five Lac Twenty Five Thousand Five Hundred only). Stolen amount is Rs 3,00,000/- (Rs Three Lac). It was in denominations of 2000 and 500. ($2000 \times 100 = 2,00,000 + 2 \times 500 \times 100 = 1,00,000$)

From Majdihe (pump location) he has travelled to Mahurgram ^{bus stand} on bike pillion with Sourav Mandi. Sourav Mandi is also a staff member of my pump. He is the son of Nabakumar Mandi, resident of vill: Chetra P.S - Onda.

From Mahurgram bus stand stop, Debinandan took a bus to Bankura. At around 13:10 hrs on 18/10/19. Name of the bus was Jungle Mahal. He

While he was standing in the queue to deposit cash, he found 3 lacs ~~missing~~ has been stolen by slicing the bag at the side.

Immediately, he calls me over telephone and reports the entire incident. Everything I have reported here is as per my conversation with him.

Yesterday I was in Kolkata, could not lodge FIR. Today (19/10/19) I have come back to do the same.

Sir/Madam, I pray for your guidance and co-operation. I need a lot of help here from authority in your position in order to navigate and neutralise this crisis.

I pray you to take necessary action so that I receive my money back. I pray you to take necessary legal action against those who are involved in putting me in such distress.
