Respected Sir,

In producing here with the accused namely Mantu Mandal (approx 45 years), S/o- Karuna Mandal of Vill- Rasulpur, P.O-Keneti, P.S- Indas, Dist - Bankura with seized I.D liquor amounting about 20 liters in a Plastic Jariken under proper seizure list and I beg to submit that today (20.11.2019) while I, S.I Mani Sankar Mahanta along with force were engaged in evening patrolling duty in P.S area, at about 18:05 hrs, I received a secret source information that some persons are selling I.D liquor at Village Rasulpur in an open place. To act to the secret source information, I informed to O/C Indas P.S over mobile phone and I along with force had been to Rasulpur and found some persons assembled in front of a house courtyard. I along with force in proper Police uniform held raid and was able to apprehend the above noted person and others managed to flee away from the spot. On interrogation, the apprehended person disclosed his name as Mantu Mandal (approx 45 years), S/o- Karuna Mandal of Vill- Rasulpur, P.O-Keneti, P.S- Indas Dist - Bankura and he also confessed that he runs the business of I.D. liquor from his house since long. On being searched, I found one plastic jariken containing approx. 20 liters of colorless liquid having strong smell of I.D. liquor which was kept hidden inside the room of his house duly produced and identified by him as I.D. liquor (approx. value Rs. 850/-). On being asked neither he nor anyone in favour of him could produce any license or valid document in respect of selling such liquor. On this circumstances, it was clear that the above accused persons namely Mantu Mandal (approx 45 years), S/o- Karuna Mandal of Vill- Rasulpur, P.O-Keneti, P.S- Indas, Dist - Bankura was selling liquors & stocking liquors with a view to wrongful gain. Accordingly, I seized the following articles in a proper seizure list duly signed by the apprehended accused person in between 19:15 and 19:35 hrs. I seized the same in presence of local witnesses and the accused person but no being asked no one came forward to sign the seizure list. Hence, I obtained signature of my accompanying force as well as the accused person and also supplied a copy of seizure list to the accused person. As he is liable to be prosecuted U/S 46 A of B.E Act as he was found selling I.D liquors openly and was caught red handed, I arrested Mantu Mandal by maintaining all the legal formalities under Memo of arrest and brought him to PS .

Seized articles:

- 1) One plastic jariken containing approx. 20 liters of colourless liquor having strong smell of I.D. liquor.
- 2) One bottle containing about 600 ml of colourless liquor having strong smell of I.D. liquor collected as sample from Sl. No-(1).

Under the above fact and circumstances, I pray that a specific case may kindly be registered against arrested accused person namely Mantu Mandal (approx 45 years), S/o- Karuna Mandal of Vill- Rasulpur, P.O-Keneti, P.S- Indas, Dist - Bankura under proper section of law and arrange for its investigation.
