Sub:- Prayer for lodging a FIR against Prakash Bagdi @ Poka, S/o- Lt. Fatik Bagdi of Vill- Sashpur Kollerpar, PS- Indas, Bankura.

Respected Sir,

In producing herewith in a plastic jariken containing colourless liquor amounting about 20 liters from which strong smell of I.D liquor is coming out (approx. value of Rs. 800/-) and one bottle containing approx 600 ml of colourless liquor having strong smell of I.D liquor collected as sample from the above noted plastic jariken under proper seizure list and label. I beg to report that today i.e. on 15.03.19 while myself along with force were engaged in patrolling duty in P.S area vide Indas P.S GDE No- 566 dtd. 18.04.2020 at about 19:15 hrs received a secret source information that one person namely Prakash Bagdi @ Poka is selling I.D liquor at Sashpur Kollerpar village from his house. To act to the secret source information, I informed the matter to O/C Indas PS immediately over mobile phone and as per his verbal direction, I along with force rushed for that spot and met with my source there. As guided by my source, keeping our vehicle in a certain distance, I along with force in proper police uniform quickly moved towards the place where I found some persons assembled in the house courtyard of the house of Prakash Bagdi @ Poka. Seeing us in police uniform, the said persons who assembled there fled away. I along with my accompanying force chased them but no one could be apprehended. Thereafter, I searched the house and found the above noted plastic jariken containing approx. 20 liters of liquor from the corner of the cooking shed of the house of Prakash Bagdi @ Poka. I opened the cap of the plastic jariken to check and found approx. 20 liters of colourless liquor having strong smell of ID liquor inside the plastic jariken. On being asked no one came forward in favour of Prakash Bagdi @ Poka or could produce any license or valid document in respect of the said liquor or his business of liquor. I also tried to collect their names from the local people who gathered on the spot, but none could tell anything about the persons who fled away. Only they informed that Prakash Bagdi @ Poka, S/o- Lt. Fatik Bagdi lives in the said house and sell I.D liquor from his house since long for wrongful gain and fled away along with others during Police raid. Under these circumstances, it was clear that the above fact Prakash Bagdi @ Poka was habitually selling I.D liquor from his house for business purpose and fled away from his house during raid. Accordingly, I seized the above noted plastic jariken from the house of accd. Prakash Bagdi @ Poka and one bottle containing approx 600 ml of colourless liquor having strong smell of ID liquor collected as sample from the above noted plastic jariken under proper seizure list duly signed by the witnesses in between 20:25 hrs and 20:45 hrs and prepared its label. I requested the local available witnesses who gathered on the spot to sign the seizure list as seizure witness but no one came forward. Finding no other alternative, I took signature of my accompanying force as seizure witness after reading it over to them in their own language. Thereafter, I returned to P.S with seized articles i.e :

- 1) One plastic jariken containing about 20 liters of colourless liquor having strong smell of I.D liquor,
- 2) One bottle containing approx. 600 ml of colourless liquor having strong smell of I.D liquor collected as sample from SI no- (1),

Under the above fact and circumstances, I pray before your kind self that a case may kindly be registered against above noted accused person under proper section of law and arrange for its investigation.
