Respected Sir,

I, an Officer of Intelligence Bureau in Ministry of Home Affairs and posted at New Delhi. I have been performing essential duty of security and cannot take leave to go home in my District Bankura.

There is some farmland (approx. 7 kms west of Onda PS) in Paharpur mouza (J.L.No.108, Kh.No.981 & Dag No.327,328 & 329) where grown-up segun (Teak) trees along with other trees were present. In the three poaching incidents occurred during lock-down period of COVID-19 pandemic throughout the country by some unknown persons with mechanized hack-saw, total thirty two (32) Nos. of segun trees were taken away after cutting down from the area. Taking the chance of my absence from home and during the lock-down period, I could only report of the crime to the concerned Onda PS.

I got the information from my brother over phone and according to him there are ample proof of the act as some of tree leaves and cuttings were strewn out all over the surroundings. It may be mentioned that on the first incident on 29 March 2020, the same type of poaching of segun trees from the same place occurred and I already informed in my previous email dated 29 March & 01st April 2020 but nothing has been done so far. Not even an FIR was lodged at Onda PS.

I am enclosing the Map and place of occurrence in the attachment along with the copy of documents of ownership of that land. Name of my wife is Rita Mukhopadhyay, the owner of the land and also resides with me.

Therefore, you are requested to look into the matter and may take the necessary steps to ensure about the unknown persons who are involved in the incident and bring them to justice as per the law of the country.




Following is the sequence of poaching incidents mentioned chronologically.

1. The first incident of poaching of segun trees (10 Nos.) occurred on the intervening night of March 28-29, 2020, and I already informed in my previous email dated 29 March & 01st April 2020 but nothing has been done so far.
2. The second incident of poaching of segun trees (10 Nos.) occurred on the intervening night of April 16-17, 2020 around mid-night the same type from the same place occurred. Informed through email on April 17, 2020.
3. The third incident of poaching of segun trees (12 Nos.) occurred on the intervening night of July 28-29, 2020 from the same area and location which I conveyed to the SHO, Onda PS over telephone (Mobile No.+919083269321) on July 29, 2020 at 12:16 PM (Noon).


I am enclosing the Photographs from the incident spot of third poaching incident mentioned above.
