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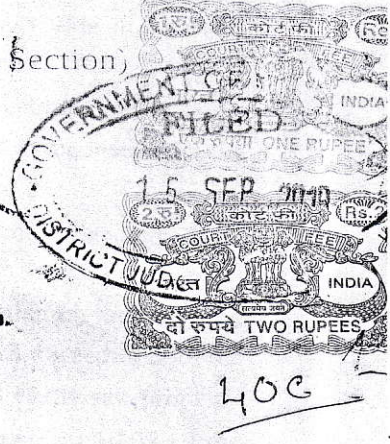
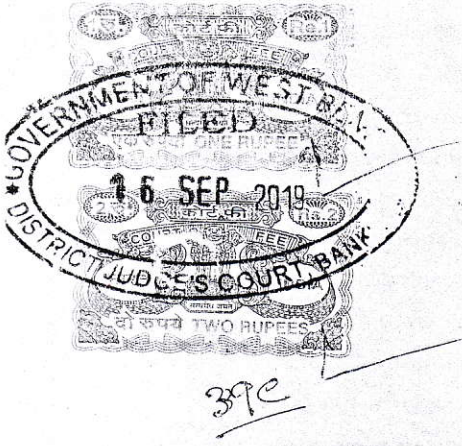

The record is put up today before me on the strength of a put up petition filed by the plaintiff along with an application under section 151 CPC, praying for police help for due implementation of the order of temporary injunction, passed by this Court vide order no. 6 dated 11.04.2018.

Ld. Advocate for the plaintiff moves the petition u/s 151 CPC for implementation of the injunction order dated 11.04.18. In view of order no. 13 dated 20.02.19 and considering the urgency of the matter, the petition is taken up for hearing on ex-parte.

Heard Ld. Advocate at length. Perused the case record, specially the order no.6 dated 11.04.18. Considered.

At the time of hearing Ld. Advocate for the plaintiff has submitted that on hearing both sides, an order of temporary injunction was passed by this Court on 11.04.18, directing both the parties to maintain 'status quo' in respect of the title, nature and character of the suit property and not to change the same till final disposal of the suit, but all of a sudden on 18.02.19 the defendant and his sons started to raise an illegal 'chala-ghar' on the suit plot no. 995/1178 by affixing 3 cemented pillars keeping support with the Western wall of existing construction. Ld. advocate further submitted that in-spite of objection raised by the plaintiff, the defendant and his sons did not pay any heed on that, rather they threatened the plaintiff and his father with dire consequences. The petition further revealed that the matter was duly informed to the local PS along with a copy of the order no. 6 dated 11.04.18, passed by this Court. Ld. lawyer concluded his submission by stating that the defendant and his sons have no regard for the order of the Court and his client reasonably apprehends that the defendant and his sons would repeatedly flout the order of temporary injunction by taking undue advantage of their muscle power. Hence this petition for an order of police help for proper implementation of the injunction order.

Considered all.

In such circumstances, the Court is of the inclined view that the order of injunction as passed by this court on 11.04.18 to the effect that "both parties i.e plaintiff and defendant to maintain 'status-quo' in respect of nature and character of the suit property till disposal of the suit" needs to be implemented with aid of police.

Hence, it is,

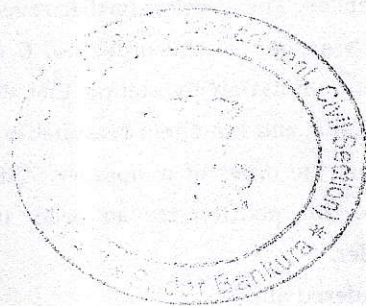
**Ordered**

that the petition u/s 151 CPC dated 21/02/2019, filed by the plaintiff is hereby considered and allowed, on ex-parte.

The O.C., Onda P.S is strictly directed to ensure that such order of injunction of this court vide order no. 6 dated 11.04.18 be implemented in its letter and spirit, by both the parties with the help of police at his end.

The O.C to ensure no party violates such order of injunction of this court and the O.C to visit the locale either personally or through his suitably deputed police personnels and also to take all possible measures to enforce the order of this court in the manner and procedure known

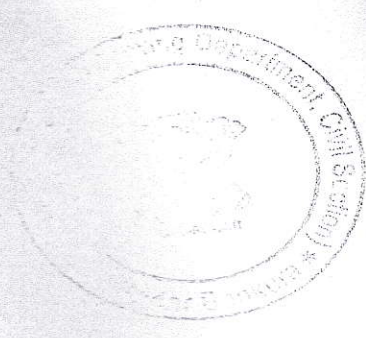

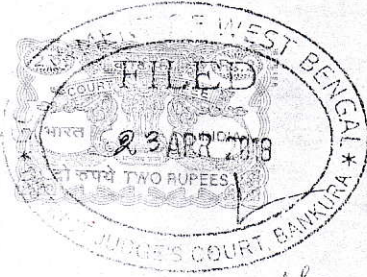

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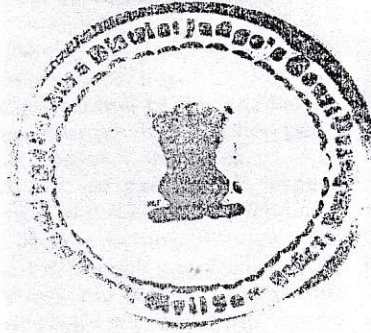

This day is fixed for hearing of petition under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 read with Section 151 of the CPC, 1908 dated 20.02.2018, filed by the plaintiff and for filing W/S. S/R returned after due service.

Plaintiff files hazira along with a prayer for extension of the order of ad-interim injunction, as passed on 22.02.2018. Let the ad-interim order of injunction be extended.

Now, the petition under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 read with Section 151 of the CPC dated 20.02.2018 is taken up for hearing.

Heard submission of the Ld. Lawyers appearing for the plaintiff as well as for the defendant. Perused the plaint, injunction petition, written objection filed by the defendant and other materials on record. Considered.

This is suit for partition in respect of suit property by metes and bounds. It is the allegation of the plaintiff that the defendant is trying to change the nature and character of the suit property, by encroaching the vacant portion of the same, to deprive the plaintiff from his legal rights and if, the defendant will succeed in his such illegal acts, then the plaintiff will suffer irreparable loss and injuries which could not be compensated by money and the same may cause of multiplicity of proceedings. To restrain the defendant from his such illegal acts, the instant petition for temporary injunction had been filed by the plaintiff.

It is the well settled principle that until partition is effected among the co-sharers by metes and bounds, each co-sharers has right in every inch of the land and no co-sharers can claim absolute possession in respect of any unpartitioned property. Unless and until partition is effected by metes and bounds no co-sharer has right to change the nature and character of the suit property and there is every chance of multiplicity of proceedings if the defendant succeeds in his such unlawful activities.

In view of the fact of this suit and considering the conduct of the defendant, against whom the order of ad-interim injunction was passed, I am of opinion that if both the parties are directed to maintain status-quo in respect of the nature and character of the suit property, till the final disposal of this suit, neither party will be prejudiced.

Hence, it is

Ordered

that the petition under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 read with Section 151 of the CPC, 1908 dated 20.02.2018, filed by the plaintiff is hereby considered and allowed on contest without cost.

Both the parties are directed to maintain status quo (as on today) in respect of the title, nature and character of the suit property and not to change the same till final disposal of the suit.

At this stage on scrutiny of the record it revealed that the notice of the main suit was duly served upon the defendant, but till date they did not file any written statement and prayed for time. Heard. Considered. Prayer is allowed.

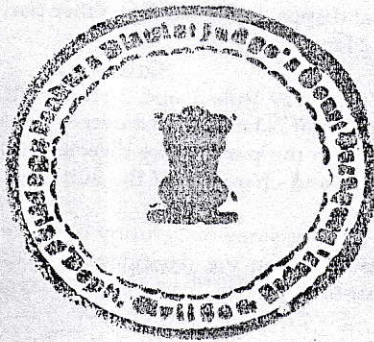
