Sub: Prayer for starting a cog. Case u/s: 379/413 /414 IPC, 33 WB Mines and Minerals Rule 2002 and 21/29 Mines and Minerals Act.

Sir,

With due respect, I, SI Swapan Mandal of Bishnupur PS, would like to draw your kind attention to the fact that today on 06.12.2020 morning at 08:45hrs, I left the PS with force for performing day mobile duty within Bishnupur PS area. This refers Bishnupur PS GDE No. 217, Dt. 06.12.2020 and CC No. 4760/2020, Dt. 06.12.2020.

In course of performing duty, I received a concrete information from one of my reliable sources that some persons have been excavating sand from the river bed of river Darakeswar with heavy duty earth movers and have been transporting sands with the help of tractor trolley. All these were being done illegally. Sand excavation was being done at following points - 1. River bed near Subhash Pally village 2. River bed near Madhuban village. I informed the matter to IC Bishnupur PS. As per his instruction, left for executing source information. I sought help from IC Radhanagar OP.

I arrived at predestined place at 11:35 hrs and conducted raid with the help of SI Bindheswar Gorai and forces of Radhanagar OP simultaneously in those places. We found 02 earth movers [having no registration numbers] and a half sand laden tractor bearing Rgd. No. WB67A/0437 on river bed. On seeing Police, the operators of earth movers and driver of a half sand laden tractor, bearing Rgd. No. WB67A/0437, fled away. I along with other Police personnel and villagers saw the signs of recent and fresh sand excavation by those machines. I seized those heavy duty earth movers and tractor with trolley under proper seizure lists. The half sand laden tractor was sent to PS under Police escort. One of those earth movers was taken to Subhash Pally village and guards were placed. Another heavy duty earth mover is kept at Kamal Bhata [Kamal brick field] compound and guards were placed there. Search and seizures were done in between 11:55hrs and 13:45hrs.

I conducted enquiries. Came to know that the entire racketeering of this illegal excavation and transportation of sand from the river beds of river Damodar is headed by one Samir Manna, s/o: Gopal Ch. Manna of Baasantitola, PS. Bishnupur, Dist. Bankura and others are there to act under his canopy.


Everyone is involved in dealing in this illegal sand excavation and transportation for of sand, headed by said Samir Manna. Also came to know from the local people that they have been dealing in this illegal sand excavation and transportation for a long time and they are habitual offenders in this regard. In a word, they are stealing sand and transporting the same for their own gain. They are, thus, depriving government from genuine revenue.

Under the above, I pray to you that a specific case u/s: 379/413 /414 IPC, 33 WB Mines and Minerals Rule 2002 and 21/29 Mines and Minerals Act against accd. Samir Manna, s/o: Gopal Ch. Manna of Baasantitola, PS. Bishnupur, Dist. Bankura and others.

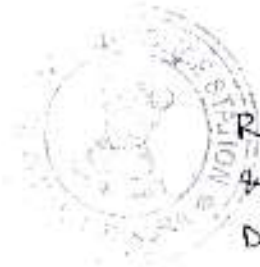
