SUB:- Written Complain against Dr. Suman Kalvan Pore and the authorities of Bishnupur Life Line Nursing Home for kidnapping my baby girl from lawful guardianship, assaulting me, concealing the evidences and criminally intimidating me coupled with a prayer for treating the same as a First Information Report.

Sir,

I, Smt. Shampa Gorai nee Purakayastha, Wife of Sri. Swarajit Purakayastha of Village- Ledagamar, Post Office- Amlagora, Police Station- Garhbeta, Dist- Paschim Medinipur would state the following:

1. That I had conceived through a procedure named Intrauterine Insemination (IUI) and I was under the active consultations of Dr. Suman Kalyan Pore since 16<sup>th</sup> February, 2020.
2. That under the advice of Dr. Suman Kalyan Pore, I was admitted to Bishnupur Lifeline Nursing Home on 22<sup>nd</sup> February, 2020 as Dr. Suman Kalyan Pore was associated with the said Nursing Home. I gave birth to a baby girl thereafter on 24<sup>th</sup> February, 2020 which I cherished leaps and bounds.
3. That I gave birth to the child at around 9:30 am on that day under the care of Dr. Suman Kalyan Pore. It is pertinent to mention that the said child was shown to my husband.
4. That thereafter the staffs of the said Nursing Home directed my husband to bring some medicine urgently for the child, a prescription for that end was given to him and my husband complied with the said direction and bought the said medicine without delay.
5. That in the meantime when my husband was away to bring the prescribed medicine, the staffs of the said Nursing Home took the child away from my sight and assured me that the child would be brought back after cleaning.
6. That a few hours had passed by but our child was not brought as promised. Hence we enquired about the whereabouts of the child. On such enquiry Dr. Suman Kalyan Pore said with utter disdain that our child had died and not only that her last rites have already been performed.
7. That on further request for the last sight of our child, the said Doctor denied that I gave birth to a child. Only a second ago he said the child passed away and now he stated that I did not give birth to a child.
8. That such attitude of the Doctor created a cauldron of suspicion in our minds and we politely asked for all our medical documents including the discharge certificate but the said Doctor and the Nursing Home Authorities bluntly said

that the documents will not be handed over to us and on persistent demand for the same the said perpetrators were on the verge of grave attack upon us which created an alarm that Criminal Force will be used upon us.

9. That owing to such assault we left the said Nursing Home licking our wounds, not only did we lose our child but we also could not get the said medical documents which could prove our case as those were important evidences to prove the fact that I gave birth to a child and I was under the supervision of the said Doctor Pore.
10. That thereafter I came to know that the said Doctor is in the habit of stealing/kidnapping children for the purposes of prostitution/flesh trade.
11. That I tried to file a complain against them but the said authorities and the Doctor are very influential, if they can kidnap a child and thereafter assault us then they can do anything.
12. That whenever we ventured out of our house the miscreants patronized by the Doctor would intimidate us stating that if we toe the line then our bodies would be towed away which prevented us from registering the FIR on an earlier date.
13. That now the said Doctor is roaming around scot-free and without a care that he could be proceeded against and therefore I found this as the right time to register this written complain.

Hence it is most humbly prayed before your goodself so that this Written Complain is accepted and is thereafter treated as a First Information Report so that the perpetrators may be punished and my grievance may be redressed.
