Subject: Assault and violation of Wildlife Protection Act
at Dhengashol, Bambura.

Dear Sir,

Here are some events that I wish to bring to your
notice:

1) I, Anil Kumar, President of Human and Environment Alliance
^{HEAL}
League visited DHENGASHOL, NEAR BISHNUPUR, BAMBURA at
around 1 pm on 4th May 2021. The purpose of this visit
was to document the ritual hunting festival that was taking
place there, in violation of Wildlife Protection Act 1972 and
orders of Calcutta High Court passed on 18/04/2019 and
26/05/2021. HEAL was a petitioner in the first of these
orders which expressly prohibited hunting of wild life.

At around 1:45 pm
2) At Dhengashol, we noticed a large crowd of hunters who
were armed with various traditional weapons, congregating in
a patch of forest. We noticed a Wild Boar (Schedule III,
Wildlife Protection Act) carcass at the location. We tried to
photograph the same as it is a violation of law and court orders.

3) While trying to document the aforementioned crime, we
were approached by an aggressive and armed mob of
hunters - I was assaulted by the mob, taken to a nearby

shift court forcibly, and my phone, car keys and photography equipment was seized. Thereafter I was manhandled and slapped around by the miscreants, I was then asked to take out the memory card from my photographic equipment (a GOR (a GoPro Hero 7) and give it to them. After this I was thrown out of the area and threatened with dire consequences if I return. They returned all my belongings apart from the memory card.

4) After this, I called up Bishnupur Police Station and a team of police personnel led by ASI Normal Satpathi was sent at the location. They helped me in getting back my memory card. I also pointed out the criminals, who assaulted me and committed the wildlife crimes. They used a car with registration No. WB68AA1651 - a Maruti Omni Van.

I would request you to take appropriate action against the miscreants for assault and violation of Wildlife Protection Act, 1972.
