Sub: Specific complaint against drivers of two vehicles for illegal possession and transportation of stone chips.

Sir,

In producing herewith accused (1) Samiul Sk (35Y) S/O- Emam Sk of Rajgram, PS- Murarai, Dist- Birbhum (Driver of vehicle no- WB 29B/5808) and (2) Kiron Sarkar (26Y) S/O- Nakphor Sarkar of Sainthia, (Lautor-1) PS- Sainthia, Dist- Birbhum (Driver of vehicle no- WB45/5942) along with two stone chips loaded vehicle- WB 45/5942 (dumper) and WB 29B/5808 (12 wheeler truck) seized vehicles and articles. I beg to submit that today (07.06.2021) at 16:55 hrs SI Binshedwar Gorain O/C Beliatore PS, received an information from his source regarding illegal transportation of stone chips on Bankura Durgapur main road. This information has been dairised vide Beliatore PS GDE no- 236 date- 07.06.2021 and as per direction of O/C Beliatore PS, to work out the said information, I ASI Dilip Kumar Singha Roy left PS along with C/619 Bikash Mondal, C/1768 Kishan Kumar Midya, C/890 Bapi Some vide Beliatore PS CC No- 920 date- 07.06.2021. At 17:05 hrs we reached at near Kalberia petrol pump and found that said two vehicles were coming from Durgapur side. Seeing the Police van, the drivers of those vehicles stopped their vehicles and started to flee away leaving behind their vehicles on the road. Chased them, and could apprehend the drivers namely Samiul Sk and Kiron Sarkar. Interrogated the accused drivers and came to learn that they are the driver of stone cheeps loaded vehicles. On demand, they could produce neither any challan nor valid document nor could give any satisfactory answer in respect of the loaded stone cheeps on their vehicles. From the interrogation it revealed that the drivers in connivance with the owners have been operating such illegal business in clandestine manner since long. They also came to learn that some persons stone cheeps loaders/lease holders are involved in operating the process of illegal loading and also violated the covid-19 norms in the lock down period as per Govt. Order Memo No. 647-ISS/2M-22/2020 Dated: 15.05.2021. Accordingly I seized the said two vehicles bearing registration no- WB 45/5942 (dumper) and WB 29B/5808 (12 wheeler truck) loaded with stone cheeps under proper seizure list duly signed by witnesses and also arrested the accused driver namely (1) Samiul Sk (35Y) S/O- Emam Sk of Rajgram, PS- Murarai, Dist- Birbhum and (2) Kiron Sarkar (26Y) S/O- Nakphor Sarkar of Sainthia, (Lautor-1) PS- Sainthia, Dist- Birbhum after maintaining all legal formalities prescribed by Apex Court and NHRC guide line under Memo of Arrest.

Under the above facts and circumstance, I request you to start a specific case against the said arrested accd persons and the owners of the said seized vehicles, and arrange for its investigation.
