Sub- Prayer for lodging FIR against the drivers and owners of the seized vehicles bearing no. WB

29B- 2526, WB33C-1375 & WB29B-4897.

Sir,

In producing herewith the arrested accused persons namely i) Sattar Bayen (24y), S/o- Mansur Bayen of Jamsull, PS- Bishnupur, Dist- Bankura, ii) Sanatan Lohar (37y), S/o- Lt Rabi Lohar of Panagarh, PS- Kanksa, Dist- Purba Burdwan and iii) Mustakim Miya (23y), S/o- Noushad Miya of Ruppur, PS- Bolpur, Dist- Birbhum along with three vehicle (Truck) bearing registration no WB29B-2526, WB33C-1375 & WB29B-4897 respectively, loaded with stone chips under proper seizure list. I SI Ratan Majumder of Bishnupur PS do hereby lodge complaint against the above noted drivers and the register owner of vehicle no WB29B-2526, WB33C-1375 & WB29B-4897 to the effect that on 07.06.2021 at 21.15 hrs received secret information from reliable source that three vehicles (truck) bearing registration no WB29B-2526, WB33C-1375 & WB29B-4897 all loaded with stone chips coming from Garbeta side via Mishrishole border through Garbeta-Bankura Pitch road (NH-60) under Bishnupur PS area without proper challan or valid documents. (This refers to Bishnupur PS G.D.E no- 334, Dtd- 07.06.2021) Accordingly as per order of I/C, Bishnupur PS, I accompanied by force namely C/269 Uttam Mandal, C/414 Fatik Ch Kar and C/1765 Sabyasachi Mishra, left PS for Morar more to work out the information. (This refers to Bishnupur PS GDE no- 335, Dtd- 07.06.2021 & C.C no- 1728 /2021, Dtd- 07.06.2021.)


At about 21.45 hrs I accompanied by force reached near Morar 1 no camp. On the way night mobile officer ASI Prabir Mandal along with C/1343 Uttam Samanta, and C/178 Kartick Ch Mandal and C/222 Sital Banerjee assist me. After reaching there I noticed that the above noted vehicles are coming towards Garbeta side. Seeing the police van, the drivers of those trucks stopped their vehicles and started to flee away leaving behind their truck on the Road. The Police party accompanying me chased the drivers and managed to apprehend them. After that I searched the vehicles and found that the vehicles are loaded with stone chips. I also searched for valid papers in respect of the vehicle and the valid documents/challan etc. in respect of procurement and transportation of the loaded stone chips. On demand, all drivers could produce neither any challan nor valid documents nor could give any satisfactory answer in respect of the loaded stone chips on their truck. Finally it has been presumed that the vehicles as well as the stone chips has been procured either by committing theft or by any illegal means and the stone chips were being transported for illegal gain in a clandestine manner. From the interrogation it revealed that and some stone cheeps loaders/lease holders are involved in operating the process of illegal loading and also violated the covid-19 norms in the lock down period as per Govt Order vide memo no- 647-ISS/2M-22/2020, dtd- 15.05.2021 Govt of WB. As such in between 22.15 hrs to 22.30 hrs I seized the vehicles bearing no. WB29B-2526, WB33C-1375 & WB29B-4897 loaded with stone chips under proper seizure list duly signed by Police witnesses as no one from the local people turned up and signed in the seizure list and also arrested the accused drivers after maintaining all legal formalities prescribed by Apex Court and NHRC guideline.

It also came to light that the drivers of the vehicle bearing no. WB29B-2526, WB33C-1375 & WB29B-4897 in connivance with the owner of the respective vehicle procuring the stone chips either by committing theft or by any illegal means and transporting the same in clandestine manner since long. Thereby they are enjoying wrongful gain by incurring wrongful loss (revenue) to the Govt. as stone is the National property and major minerals.

Under the circumstances I pray that a specific case may kindly be registered under proper section of law against the drivers and owners of the seized vehicles bearing no. WB29B-2526, WB33C-1375 & WB29B-4897.


