Sub: Specific complaint against drivers of Dumper for illegal possession and transportation of morum.

Sir,

In producing herewith accused (1) Rustam Ali Sarkar (50 yrs) s/o- Lt. Pachiruddin Sarkar of Chadahati, PS- Tapan, Dist- Dakshin Dinajpur, (2) Bijoy Yadav (35 yrs) s/o- Lt. Dhaneswar Yadav of Kharagpur, Ps- Mohanpur, Dist- Goya (Bihar), (3) Biplab Mahanta (39 yrs) s/o- Narendranath of Sewai, PS- Balurghat, Dist- Dakshin Dinajpur & (4) Shibu Karktta (36 yrs) s/o- Bishu Karktta of Baul, PS- Kumarganj, Dist- Dakshin Dinajpur along with following seized vehicles and articles. I beg to submit that today (06.06.2021) at 20.35 hrs while myself along with force was engaged in evening petrol at Deshra Koalpara side received an information from SI. Manas Chatterjee, O.C. Kotulpur PS, which he got from source regarding illegal transportation of Moram along Arambag Bishnupur pitch road. This information has been diarised at Kotulpur PS vide GDE No- 287 dtd. 06.06.2021 and as per direction of O.C. Kotulpur PS myself along with fore started movement on the road at 20.45 hrs intercepted 04 Dumpers bearing No- (1) WB 19H- 3600, (2) WB 19H- 3420, (3) WB 19H- 3510 & (4) WB 19H- 3501 loaded with moram under cover of Tarpolin at Ankargeria area. During persuasion 04 drivers of those trucks were found on the starting of their respective vehicles as noted each (1) WB 19H- 3600- Driver of the vehicle namely Rustam Ali Sarkar, (2) WB 19H- 3420 Driver of the vehicle namely Bijoy Yadav, (3) WB 19H- 3510 Driver of the vehicle namely Biplab Mahanta & (4) WB 19H- 3501 Driver of the vehicle namely Shibu Karktta. I also found morams were loaded in the said dampers being interrogated all above 04 drivers failed to produce either any valid documents or valid explanation regarding which transportation in the Covid Pandemic situation as the drivers could not produce any documents in support of possession and transportation in respect of morams. It is crystal clear that they have loaded morams in their vehicles by any fraudulent means after stealing it from moram quarry. The drivers move stated that they were habituated in such type of act by clandestine manner in connivance with their trucks were taking the opportunity of the situation. The morum seems to be overloaded though I could not weight the morum as Weight Bridge are presently closed in our area. This exercise will be done by tomorrow as early as possible.

Being asked the drivers reported that they obtained these morums from morum quarry of under Garbeta area.

This act of the drivers is punishable u/s 379/411/413/414/120B/188 IPC and 21 of Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act – 1957 and section 51(b) of Disaster Management Act.
