Sub: Specific complaint against driver of Dumper for illegal possession and transportation of stone chips.

Sir,

In producing herewith accused Suman Dhaur (29 yrs) , s/o- Lt. Sanatan Dhaur, Vill- Pumiya, P.O-Thampur, PS- Jama, Dist- Dumka, State- Jharkhand, along with following seized vehicle and article. I beg to submit that today (08.06.2021) at 06.05 hrs while myself along with force was engaged in night petrol at Deshra bazar side received an information from SI. Manas Chatterjee, O.C. Kotulpur PS, which he got from source regarding illegal transportation of stone chips along Arambag Bishnupur pitch road. This information has been diarised at Kotulpur PS vide GDE No- 349 dt.d. 08.06.2021 and as per direction of O.C. Kotulpur PS myself along with force started movement on the road at 06.25 hrs intercepted Dumper bearing No- WB 45-5283 loaded with stone chips under at Sarishadighi area. During persuasion driver of said Dumper is found on the starting of his respective vehicle as noted above. I also found stone ships were loaded in the said damper being interrogated the driver failed to produce either any valid documents or valid explanation regarding which transportation in the Covid Pandemic situation as the driver could not produce any documents in support of possession and transportation in respect of stone chips. It is crystal clear that he has loaded stone chips in his vehicle by any fraudulent means after stealing it from stone chips. The driver more stated that he is habituated in such type of act by clandestine manner in connivance with his dumper taking the opportunity of the situation. The stone chips seems to be overloaded. So I weigh the stone chips.

Being asked the driver reported that he obtained these stone chips from stone quarry of under Rampurhat area.

This act of the driver is punishable u/s 379/411/413/414/120B/188 IPC and 21 of Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act – 1957 and section 51(b) of Disaster Management Act.
