Sub: Specific complaint against owner & driver of Tractor for illegal possession and transportation of Sand.

Sir,

In producing herewith 01 tractor bearing No- (i) WB 68X/2811 loaded with sand. I beg to submit that today (11.06.2021) at 18:35 hrs while myself along with force was engaged in mobile duty at Majdiha GP area received an information from source regarding illegal transportation of Sand through Makurgram to Joykrishnapur pitch road. This information has been diarised at Onda PS vide GDE No- 449 dtd. 11.06.2021 and as per direction of O.C. Onda PS myself along with force started movement on the road at 18.55 hrs intercepted 01 tractor bearing No- (i) WB 68X/2811 loaded with Sand. During persuasion 01 driver of the tractor was found on the starting of his respective tractor. Seeing Police, the driver of the said tractor stop his tractor near Majdiha GP Office and flee away from the spot. Myself along with force chased him but fail. After local enquiry I came to know that the driver of the tractor bearing no-WB68X/2811 namely Bhandu Roy S/O-Dasu Roy of Vill-Radhamohanpur P.S-Onda, Dist-Bankura and the owner namely Mritunjoy Ghosh S/O-Lt. Naba Kr. Ghosh of Vill-Kuchisole, P.S-Onda, Dist-Bankura both were involved in this matter. On being search I could not found any papers at the said tractor over the sand transportation. It is crystal clear that they have loaded sand in his tractor by any fraudulent means after stealing it from sand quarry which transportation in the Covid Pandemic situation.

Hence, I prayed to you kindly start a specific case in against them and take action as per law.
