COMPLAINT UNDER SECTION 156 (3) CRPC AGAINST ABOVE ACCUSED PERSON

THE COMPLAINANT MOST RESPECTFULLY BEGS TO STATE FOLLOWING:

THAT ON 14/04/2021 at about 4 P.M. in the afternoon a gang of dacoit led by Parijat Chakraborty S/O Biswanath Chakraborty resident at Village: Chandrakona Road, Ps: Garbeta, District: Paschim Medinipur had committed criminal trespass in the college which is situated at village: Hetagora, Post: Garbeta, Ps: Bishnupur, District: Bankura same is known as Bishnupur Private ITI College alongwith six unknown persons who also carried one Power Shaw which is a house breaking tool/instrument with the help of which they had broken open locks of Office where cash is kept, Principals room and two classrooms, berged into office and committed theft of RS 35,000(rupees thirty five thousand) from cash box, destroyed CCTV Machine with the help of two technicians who also accompanied such theft, dacoity, applied criminal force, posed intimidation to set fire in the college also locked from outside so that no person can suspect. It is pertinent to maintain here that said Parijat Chakraborty S/O Biswanath Chakraborty resident at Village: Chandrakona Road, Ps: Garbeta, District: Paschim Medinipur executed one sell agreement of the Bishnupur Private ITI College for RS 1,50,00,000(rupees one crore and fifty lacs) only in favour of the complainant. In spite of that sell agreement committed above gruesome incidents. Complainant have already paid RS 88,00,000(rupees eighty eight lacs) to said Parijat Chakraborty and more caused wrongful loss to me. Delay caused due to falling ill. After lodging complaint I.C Bishnupur police station has neither taken any legal action against the accused persons nor has recovered stolen articles including cash RS 35,000.

Hence it is most graciously being prayed that your Honour may be pleased to pass an order to the I.C Bishnupur Police Station to treat this complaint as FIR under section 156(3) CRPC and take necessary legal action against all the accused persons who had committed Trespass with intent to commit dacoity, committed theft of RS 35,000(rupees thirty five thousand) from cash box, gang carried house breaking tool/instrument like power shaw with the help of which tool broke locks of Bishnupur Private ITI College on 14/04/2021 at about 4 P.M. in the afternoon, destroyed CCTV Machine, Criminal Force,
