Sub:- Prayer to lodge FIR against owner and driver of tractor bearing registration No. WB-67A/4436 fitted with a trolley without number plate and others.

Sir,

In producing herewith one seized tractor bearing registration No. WB-67A/4436 fitted with a trolley without number plate loaded with sand along with seizure list I, ASI Pankaj Patra of Bankura PS, do here by lodge complaint to the effect that today i.e on 11.08.2021 at 21.15 hrs as per your kind order myself accompanied with force (vide Bankura C.C. No. 4479/21 dated 11.08.2021) were performing mobile patrolling duty in PS area. During my duty I received secret source information that some illegal sand loaded tractors are coming from Sonadaha Village side. I shared the information to my superiors and after getting instructions from superiors myself along with force placed naka at Sonadaha more to intercept those tractors. After a while, I found that the above noted tractor having bearing registration No. WB-67A/4436 fitted with a trolley without number plate loaded with sand was coming from Sonadaha Village side. Myself with the help of forces stopped the tractor at Sonadaha more. Said driver of the tractor fled away from the tractor. During local enquiry it could be learnt that the sand was lifted illegally from Gandheswari river bed by fraudulent means and he was transporting the same elsewhere to sell during lock down period for their personal gain, getting consent of the tractor owner. I also came to learn that some other persons (Illegal sand mafia) are also involved in operating the process of illegal mining and transporting sand. During further enquiry I came to learn that the owner and driver of tractor bearing registration No. WB-67A/4436 and others are operating this illegal sand business in a clandestine manner since long. They have also violated the covid-19 norms in the lock down period as per Govt. Order Memo No. 647-ISS/2M-22/2020 Dated: - 15.05.21. Accordingly I ASI Pankaj Patra of Bankura PS seized the above noted tractor with trolley loaded with sands under proper seizure list duly signed by witnesses.

During enquiry I also learnt that one Jayanta Ghosh S/O- Gobardhan of Village- Sonadaha, PS- Bankura, Dist- Bankura is the owner of this tractor and sand loaded trolley and he is directly involved in this case. He along with his driver and other associates are running this illegal activities of lifting and transporting of sand from Gandheswari river illegally since long.

Under this circumstance I pray that a specific case may kindly be started under proper section of law for investigation of this matter.
