**Sub: Threat meted out by the son and daughter-in-law of the undersigned to dispossess the undersigned and his old, ailing wife from the property lying in the name of the wife of the undersigned in order to grab the property and also inflicting torture upon the undersigned and his old and ailing wife both physically and mentally for which reason the undersigned seek protection of life and property from the evil hands of his son and daughter-in-law.**

Sir,

The undersigned begs to state the following before your goodself for your intervention and render protection of the undersigned and to ensure his peaceful stay in his property with his old, ailing wife.

The wife of the undersigned is the absolute owner of the house property situated at Village and Post Office-Bon Radhanagar, Police Station- Bishnupur, District- Bankura. The wife of the undersigned purchased the said property from the erstwhile owner by a Registered Deed of Conveyance dated 30.04.1986 and since purchase of the said property, the undersigned and his wife started living there with their son, Sri Soumya Sengupta. The undersigned is a senior citizen and aged about 70 years and he is living with his old and ailing wife who is now 62 years of age.



The undersigned is quite helpless with his ailing wife, who is now 62 years of age and his only son, Soumya Sengupta is also staying in the said house property with his wife, Smt. Rekha Jharimunna, who happens to be the daughter-in-law of the undersigned.

The son and daughter-in-law of the undersigned are trying to grab the property by dispossessing the undersigned and his old and ailing wife with an intention to develop the said property

From the month of June, 2021 the said son and daughter-in-law of the undersigned started torturing the undersigned and his old and ailing wife mentally and thereafter physically by beating the undersigned and his wife with sticks, by throwing salt and chilly powder on their eyes and also by stopping two square meals of a day. The said son of the undersigned and his wife, Rekha Jharimunna are also threatening the undersigned together with his wife with dire consequences, if the property is not handed over to the son of the undersigned. The said son of the undersigned and his wife have put padlock on all the rooms under possession of the undersigned and made his life miserable with repeated mental and physical torture.

In the aforesaid unwanted and unlawful activities on the part of the son and daughter-in-law of the undersigned, he along with his old and ailing wife do not feel safe and secure in their residential house at Bon Radhanagar and the undersigned apprehends that he along with his wife may be forcefully ousted from the said residential house by his son and daughter-in-law on any day.

The said house property is the self acquired property of the wife of the undersigned by virtue of transfer of title and his said son and daughter-in-law have no right, title and interest so long as his wife is alive. The undersigned is in actual, physical possession of the said property till today and he seeks protection of his property from the evil clutches of his son and daughter-in-law which may be ensured from your end.

The undersigned therefore earnestly request your goodself to be kind enough to register this complaint as First Information Report and take appropriate steps against the said Soumya Sengupta and his wife, Rekha Jharimunna, the son and daughter-in-law respectively of the undersigned at once and to ensure safety and security and possession of the undersigned and his wife immediately.

And for this act of kindness, the undersigned shall remain ever grateful.
