REQUEST FOR LODGING FIR FOR MISSING OF CASH AND  
JEWELLERY FROM HOME

1. With due respect and humble submission, I beg to state the following few lines for your kind consideration and favourable action please.
2. I, Nb Sub Barun Paul S/O Sri Subhas Paul is a resident of Marui Bazar, Goalapara, Bishnupur presently posted at Panagarh Military Station. Recently, I sold a plot in my name and had kept Rs 3,85,000/- in Almirah in our home. On 16 Aug 21, my wife was searching for something in Almirah, found that a gold chain and noya are missing. Further, during search it is also came to light that Rs 1,52,000/- has been missing out of Rs 3,85,000/-. We suspect that Miss Parthana Kale, a School teacher of Bishnupur Heritage School who imparts home tuition to my daughter on the following context -
  - (a) My daughter Miss Aishani Paul took admission in Class VI in Bishnupur Heritage School on 04 Jun 21 from Pathankot consequent to my transfer on permanent posting. My wife received a call from Miss Parthana Kale, a teacher of Heritage School who offered for home tuition to my daughter. Further, she came to teach my daughter in our home from first week of July. Further, she used to lock the room from inside while teaching.
  - (b) In addition, She started practicing to locking the room from inside in the pretext of changing her dress staying alone. Therefore, it indicates her malafide intention and we suspect of her of stealing the jewellery and cash as mentioned at Para 2 above.
3. May I request you to lodge an FIR for the loss and take necessary action so that the above stolen items can be recovered.
4. No other person except Miss Parthana Kale has come to my home for last one month.
