Sub:- Prayer for lodging FIR against accused Somai Murmu (48 years) S/O Lt. Kalipada Murmu of vill- Fulhari, P.S-Simlapal, Dist. Bankura.

Respected Sir,

In producing herewith seized article i.e. 20 (ten) litres I.D. liquor in a 02 (two) plastic made container each 10 Liters I do hereby submit complaint against accused Somai Murmu (48 years) S/O Lt. Kalipada Murmu of vill- Fulhari, P.S-Simlapal, Dist. Bankura to the effect that on 04.09.2021 at about 13.15 hrs in course of day mobile duty received source information that Somai Murmu (48 years) S/O Lt. Kalipada Murmu of vill- Fulhari, P.S-Simlapal, Dist. Bankura have been preparing ID Liquor in his house. I informed the fact to I/C Simlapal P.S and as per his order left for vill- Fulhari under Simlapal P.S, Dist. Bankura along with force, Kit Box to work out the information, and held raid at the house of Somai Murmu (48 years) S/O Lt. Kalipada Murmu at about 13.35 hrs. as per source information. In the mean time, seeing us i.e. police persons, above noted person fled away from his house to avoid Police arrest.

I found the house was mud built there is an one side open shed having clay made burning place (CHULA), 02(two) numbers of tin loaded with Molasses and 2 (two) plastic made container loaded with fermented wash, Earthen Apparatus etc.

I seized the articles as ALAMAT under proper Seizure List in between 13.35 hrs to 14.05. hrs

- i. **02 (two) plastic made 10 (ten) ltrs. container** containing liquid approximately 10 liters each appearing to have been Illicit Liquor, 02 bottle containing 375 M.L. each approx taken out of the above as sample packed, labeled and sealed with sealing wax in presence of available Police witnesses due to unavailable local witnesses
- ii. Molasses approx 10 Kgs in a 02(Two) plastic made container. 02 bottle containing 500 M.L. each approx taken out of the above as sample packed, labeled and sealed with sealing wax in presence of available Police witnesses due to unavailable local witnesses
- iii. 02(Two) plastic made container of 15 kg Fermented Wash approximately. 02 bottle containing 500 M.L. each approx taken out of the above as sample packed, labeled and sealed with sealing wax in presence of available Police witnesses due to unavailable local witnesses
- iv. One Earthen distillatory Apparatus.  
*Articles in Sl no ii & iii as above destroyed after seizure and sample collection.*  
*Articles in Sl no iv as above destroyed after seizure and keeping the distillatory apparatus as sample.*

Since, the I.D. liquor and other related articles was found in the premises of his house, it can be said beyond doubt that I.D. liquor was getting prepared there illegally, I pray before you to start a case under proper section of law against accused Somai Murmu (48 years) S/O Lt. Kalipada Murmu of vill- Fulhari, P.S-Simlapal, Dist. Bankura and arrange for its investigation.
