Sub-Prayer lodging FIR against Chandidas Hansda(38ys) S/o Lt. Laxmikanta Hansda of Vill Baurisole,
PO Chaka, P.S Khatra, Dist Bankura.

Sir,

In producing herewith one accused namely Chandidas Hansda(38ys) S/o Lt. Laxmikanta Hansda of Vill Baurisole, PO Chaka, P.S Khatra, Dist Bankura along with seized articles e.g.(1) tractor without registration number plate, having Engine no-E3609385, Chassis no-T053542786AK, (2) a trolley attached with above mentioned tractor, without any registration number; which is half filled with sand (3) three spades (4) two "Gaiti" (5) Five iron made "Dhama" etc. I beg to submit that on 24.04.2023 at about 11.45 hrs when I was performing RT mobile duty at Dedua crossing under PS Khatra, I received information from my source that some persons were extracting sand from the bed of Kurulpahari canal. After receiving this information I informed my superior and myself along with force left for Kurulpahari to verify the information. At about 12.15hrs I reached at Kurulpahari and my source had shown me the place from where the sand was extracting. When I proceeded towards the place I found that some persons were taking out sand from the canal bed of Kurulpahari canal and storing sand in a trolley which was attached with a tractor. But seeing the Police vehicle they started to flee away. After a hot chase we could managed to apprehend a person but others fled away. It was a lonely place and about 300 Mtrs away from Kurulpahari-Sinduerpati road. So on search no public was found there. On being asked the apprehended person disclosed his identity as Chandidas Hansda(38ys) S/o Lt. Laxmikanta Hansda of Vill Baurisole, PO Chaka, P.S Khatra, Bankura. He further confessed that he is a driver of the tractor and 4/5 persons who were fled away were the labourer who were taking out sand from the canal bed. He also confessed that the owner of the tractor namely Tarapada Majhi S/o Lt. Amullya Majhi of Khayerbani, PS Khatra, Dist Bankura engaged them to take out sand from the canal bed and to remove the extracted sand from there in tractor, so that it could be sold subsequently. He also confessed that the sand which was loaded in the trolley, was illegally taken out from the canal bed of Kurulpahari canal. On demand Chandidas Hansda failed to produce any valid documents in support of taking out sand from the place. So as sand was taking out illegally from the canal bed of Kurulpahari canal, I seized the tractor which has no registration number and having Engine no.-E3609385, Chassis no. T053542786AK along with trolley which has also no registration number along with other articles as mentioned above under proper seizure list. The trolley was half filled with sand which was illegally taken out from the canal bed. The seizure was done from 12.35hrs to 13.15hrs. Then I arrested Chandidas Hansda(38ys) S/o Lt. Laxmikanta Hansda of Vill Baurisole, PO Chaka, P.S Khatra, Bankura for illegally taking out sand.

I, therefore, pray before you that a specific case may kindly be started against Chandidas Hansda(38ys) S/o Lt. Laxmikanta Hansda of Vill Baurisole, PO Chaka, P.S Khatra, Bankura and to arrange.
