Subject- Prayer for lodging FIR.

Sir,

In producing here with the arrested accused person namely- Rohit Mandal (26Y) S/O- Aul Mandal of Village- Rampur (Patjore), PS- Sonamukhi, Dist- Bankura along with seized 1) approx. 18 ltrs of liquor having strong smell of ID liquor in a plastic jariken, 2) One bottle containing 375 ml ID liquor having strong smell of ID liquor, collected as sample from the seized Jariken Sl. No.1 and 3) One old by cycle with original seizure list.

The fact of the case is that today on 25.09.2023 at 10:25 hrs. during performing my mobile duty vide GDE no- 1065 date- 25.09.2023 and CC no- 2168/23, I received an information from my reliable source that the above noted arrested person is coming from Nimtola village near Shali River with carrying ID liquor for selling in the locality. Accordingly, I informed the fact to my O/C and as per direction of my O/C, I along with C/619 Bikash Mondal, C/1768 Kishan Kumar Middya and HG 61 Sanjib Kamilla left for Nimtola village near Shali River to work out the information. At 11:15 hrs arrived at Nimtola village near Shali River and stay here and found that the above noted person was coming from Niltola Bus stand side in a by-cycle, after seeing police party he tried to fled away, but we managed to detained him and after detained I found that there was a plastic jariken in his by-cycle, I checked the said plastic jariken and found it loaded approx. 18 ltrs liquor having strong smell of ID liquor. On interrogation it could be learnt that he carrying this ID liquor with a view sell in the locality. I asked to produce for any valid documents in respect of carrying or selling of this ID liquor, but he failed to produce any permission, or any valid documents in respect of this. Accordingly, I seized 1) approx. 18 ltrs liquor having strong smell of ID liquor in one plastic jariken, 2) One bottle of 375 ml containing ID liquor collected from the seized Jariken as sample and 3) One old by cycle under proper seizure list in presence of the witnesses and arrested him after maintain all the legal formalities of arrest rule of NHRC and Appex Court.

Under the above circumstance, I request you to start a specific case against the said - Rohit Mandal (34y) S/O- Aul Mandal of Village- Rampur (Patjore), PS- Sonamukhi, Dist- Bankura and arrange for its investigation.
