Sub: Prayer for lodging FIR.

Sir,

I SI Kuntal Kanti Sinha of Gangajalghati PS do here by inform you that, on 08.11.2023 at about 06:25 hrs, I received a telephonic information from duty officer of G.Ghati PS SI Vivekananda Chatterjee that one Suvodip Mishra @ Dipu of Nidhirampur village was hanging from a tree in front of his house with a noose around his neck. This incident was diarized in our Police Station vide Gangajalghati PS GDE No 379 dt. 08.11.2023 and I informed the matter to IC Gangajalghati PS and myself along with IC Gangajalghati PS and force including Lady Police personnel vide CC No-1067/23 Dated- 08.11.2023 rushed to the spot to work out the information and found that one Suvodip Mishra @ Dipu was hanging from a tree in the village located beside Shiv Mandir. There we found many local villagers had assembled under the leadership of Smt. Chandana Bauri, MLA Saltora and they were causing hindrance to perform our duty. However, after much persuasion, we somehow managed to bring down the body of Suvodip Mishra from the tree to transfer him at Amarkanan RH for further formalities. On the way, when we were heading towards hospital in an ambulance from Nidhirampur village, suddenly I found the BJP supporters under the leadership of **1) Rajib Tewari @ Raju 2) Bipaktaran Gorai 3) MLA Saltora Smt. Chandana Bauri and others** restrained us to move to the Hospital by blocking our way and hackling the police personnel to perform Govt. duty smoothly. Suddenly the mob became furious and started to pelt stones at us causing damage to one Govt vehicle No- WB 68D /3615. MLA Chandana Bauri also laid down in front of our vehicle to restrain us. They also pushed and assaulted me and other police personnel present there to deter us from performing our duty. In the process, myself as well as LC/2072 Suparna Masanta both of Gangajalghati PS sustained injury upon our body. We somehow made our way out and brought Suvodip Mishra to Amarkanan RH where the attending doctor declared him as brought dead. Subsequently, an Unnatural Death case was recorded at Gangajalghati PS vide U/D Case no 67/23 Dated 08/11/2023 and the dead body of deceased Suvodip Mishra was sent to BSMCH Bankura for holding PM examination after preparing Inquest. Subsequently, myself as well as LC/2072 Suparna Masanta all of Gangajalghati PS were treated at Amarkanan Rural Hospital and headed towards our Police Station.

Subsequently, on 08.11.2023 at about 13:00 hrs, when I was returning back to PS from Amarkanan Rural Hospital, I found that the BJP supporters namely **1) Rajib Tewari @ Raju 2) Manoj Chatterjee 3) Bipaktaran Gorai 4) Manoj Mondal 5) Pradip Gorai 6) Ajoy Maji 7) Madhusudan Bhandari 8) Simanta Dubey 9) Baidyanath Hansda 10) Swapan Ghosh 11) Shyamal Gorai 12) Sunil Rudra Mondal 13) Supriti Chatterjee 14) Tumpa Karmakar** and some others being led by **MLA Saltora Smt. Chandana Bauri** blocked NH 60 Road in front of our police station by showing agitation on NH60 with flag and festoon of BJP party and they fully blocked the NH-60 thereby stranding vehicles on both the sides causing inconvenience to the common public. I ordered the said supporters to withdraw the road blockade but they did not pay any heed of my words rather they became more aggressive and started to use filthy languages upon all the police personnel also insulting the state Govt. They continued the road blockade resulting which the traffic was stopped on the NH60 and finally after much persuasion, they withdrew at around 14:30 hrs., Hence, they committed offence by making the Highway impassable & unsafe for travelling or conveying the property for around 2 hours.

Under the above fact and circumstances, I pray to you for starting a specific case under proper section of law against all the above noted accused persons and oblige.
