Sub: Prayer for starting a cog. Case u/s: 379/413 /414 IPC, 33 WB Mines and Minerals Rule 2002 and 21/29 Mines and Minerals Act.

Sir,

With due respect, I, ASI -1300 Sanjib Debnath of Ranibandh PS, Dist.- Bankura would like to draw your kind attention to the fact that today on 11.01.2024 at 07:35 hrs, I left the PS with force for performing morning mobile duty within Ranibandh PS area as per order This refers Ranibandh PS GDE No. 432, Dt. 11.01.2024 and CC No. 109 /2024, Dt. 11.01.2024.

In course of performing duty. I received concrete information from one of my reliable sources that some persons have been excavating sand from the river bed of river Bhairabagi, and have been transporting sands with the help of tractor trolley via Ranibandh Hospital Para which is under PS Ranibandh, Dist. Bankura, All the are being done illegally as there is no Govt approved sand mine in close vicinity. I informed the matter to IC Ranibandh PS.

At 12:15 hrs. I arrived at Ranibandh Hospital Para which is under PS Ranibandh, Dist Bankura and noticed one tractors with sand loaded trolleys. On seeing Police, the tractor drivers and few persons fled away leaving sand loaded tractor trolleys behind at Ranibandh Hospital Para . One of tractor (Mahindra) having bearing Reg. No. WB 68AA/8179 Engine No. NKM2RHE0001 and Chassis No. MBNADAKALKNMO2301 with attached Trolley loaded with sand approx. 80 cft.(No number plate of Trolley), I seized the 01(one) tractor with sand loaded trolleys under proper seizure lists Villagers witnessed the entire process of raid, search and seizure, but refused to sign on seizure list So. I took the signatures of my accompanying forces in seizure list, Seizure started an 12:35 hrs and completed at 13:05 hrs.

I conducted enquiries: Came to know that the illegal excavation and transportation of sand from the river bed of river Bhairabagi, is being conducted by a racket. The owners of the tractor, drivers of the tractor and others are the integral part of this racket also came to know from the local people that this racket has been dealing in this illegal sand excavation and transportation for a long time and they are habitual offenders in this regard. In a word, they are stealing sand and transporting the same for their own gun of profit. They are, thus, depriving government from genuine revenues and causing imbalance in ecosystem.

Under the above, I pray to you that a specific case u/s: 379/413/414 IPC 33 WB Mines and Minerals Rule 2002 and 21/29 Mines and Minerals Act may kindly be started against the owner of the tractor, the drivers of the tractor and others who are involved in illegal sand excavation and transportation
