Sir,

In producing herewith the following arrested accd. persons namely (1) Sk. Gulchand (27 Yrs) S/O Lt. Sk. Jabbar of Idgamahalla PS & Dist-Bankura (2) Sk. Asgar (26 Yrs) S/O Lt. Sk. Aslam of Kumargara, Jamdori PS-Chhatna Dist-Bankura A/P Machantala (near Mini market) under PS & Dist-Bankura and the following seized articles viz. i) One Computer Monitor of Elista Company having serial No. ELS-V 2201 (ii) One CPU, whose cabinet made of Xcess company, (iii) One mini printer of Epson Company having serial No. L9JF005222, (iv) One mouse of Elista company having Bar Code specification No. 23267702308654614779, (v) One Key Board of Foxin company having Bar Code specification No. FKB10220100126903, (vi) One UPS of Zebeion Company having Bar Code specification No. CC00161021UPS000100904, (vii) One charging adaptor of Epson company, (viii) One optical router of S-Net company having model No. SNET-3101, IP 192.168.1.1, (ix) Some used printer paper roll, (x) Few (Play 2 Win Casino) Slips and connecting cables, (xi) Cash Rs. 670/- seized as board money, I, ASI Dilip Kumar Singha Roy of Bankura P.S do hereby lodge this complaint to the effect on 12.02.24 at about 19.15 hrs I received a secret source information that some persons are playing online gambling in "Zhoom power supplier", near Machantola masjid market under Bankura P.S. Accordingly myself along with force left for the said place to work out the information with our Govt. vehicle. At about 19.20 hrs we reached at near Machantola Masjid Market & kept our P.S vehicle at a distance and as led by the secret source went near the shop on foot. Some persons who were engaged in online gambling outside the said shop, ran away after seeing the police. However two persons were apprehended who were inside the shop. we noticed that online gambling (Play 2 Win Casino) is going on in the monitor and also found that there were some notes (currency) and some (Play 2 Win Casino) slips around the said notes. On being asked they stated their identity as above and also stated that they were playing online gambling with a view to wrongful gain of one and wrongful loss to others. During interrogation they admitted that they used to play online gambling in this shop since long. With the help of my accompanied officers and force I searched the shop which is used as gaming shop.

During search I could find the above noted articles in that shop. All the above noted articles were seized under proper seizure list. I asked the local people for signature on the seizure list, but they did not turn up, so the police personnel signed in the seizure list as witness.

I have arrested the accused persons U/S- 5 of the West Bengal Gambling & Prize Competition Act, 1957 for proper investigation of this case as they committed an offence which is punishable U/S- 3/4 of the West Bengal Gambling & Prize Competition Act, 1957. During arrest I, issued them memo of arrest, explained them the grounds of arrest and also arranged to inform their relatives regarding their arrest.

They have been arrested on the following grounds:

- 1) They may commit further offence.
- 2) They may abscond.
- 3) They may tamper with the evidences of the case by threatening local witnesses.
- 4) Their presence in the Ld. Court cannot be ensured whenever required if they not be arrested.
- 5) Gambling has a very bad impact in the society. It creates serious offences like theft, murder etc.

Under these circumstances, I pray for starting a specific case against the above noted arrested accused persons.
