Sir,

On the basis of requisition sent by IC Bishnupur PS apropos above reference and subsequently endorsed by CMOH, Bishnupur Health District I held inspection in between 20:30 hrs and 22:00 Hrs on 22.02.24 along with SI Arindam Senapati and other police personnel of Bishnupur PS at the house of Suman Kaity S/O Lt Biswanath Kaity at Boilapara, Ward No 13, Bishnupur Municipality where huge spoilt meat was reportedly kept stored by said Suman Kaity for selling purpose. On inspection it was found that there were three refrigerators at veranda of the house of said Suman Kaity. Out of said 3 refrigerators two were fully loaded with rotten chicken with foul smell which appeared as noxious for human health. Being asked he could not produce any valid license for selling meat as well.

Hence I seized more or less 60 Kg rotten chicken with foul smell which were kept stored in two refrigerators and took 3 samples, 500 grms each from it. I also seized aforementioned two refrigerators. Above seized articles were sealed, labeled at PO. Samples are being sent to West Bengal Public Health Laboratory for Food Analyst's Opinion observing slandered operating procedure. Rest seized articles along with seizure list and other pertinent documents are being handed over to you herewith.

Meat shop of said Suman Kaity at Gopalganj, Ward No 13, Bishnupur Municipality styled as Kaity Mutton and Chicken Centre was also Inspected but no meat was stored there. On examination said Suman Kaity stated that he used to store all meat at his house.

It is pertinent to note here that one available independent witness viz Manu Majhi was present with us during entire inspection, seizure and labeling period and Rs. 255/- for 1.5 Kg sample meat has been paid to said Suman Kaity by me under proper acknowledgement receipt.

Hence I request you that a case be registered against Suman Kaity U/S 273 IPC & section 50/51/52/56/63 of the Food Safety and Standards Act 2006 for investigation.
