Sub: - Prayer for lodging of F.I.R against the absconding accused person namely Sahadeb Mal (Age-35 Yrs), S/o-Fatik Mal of Vill-Kurpa (Malpara), Po-Gunnath, P.S- Indpur, Dist- Bankura.

Respected Sir,

With due respect, I ASI Sib Sankar Ghosh of Indpur PS, Dist-Bankura, do hereby lodge the suo moto complaint against the absconding accused person namely Sahadeb Mal (Age-35 Yrs), S/o-Fatik Mal of Vill-Kurpa (Malpara), Po-Gunnath, P.S- Indpur, Dist- Bankura who was selling colourless liquor in his house. Today i.e on 19.02.2024 at 18:25 hrs I received a secret source information that sell of Country Spirit liquor is going on in the house of Sahadeb Mal, S/o-Fatik Mal of Vill-Kurpa (Malpara), Po-Gunnath, P.S- Indpur, Dist- Bankura. Accordingly, I informed the matter to OC Indpur P.S and as per his kind direction, myself with accompanying force C/120 Gurucharan Chand & NVF-161 Raju Bauri vide CC no-326 dated-19.02.2024 and GDE no-667 dated-19.02.2024 held raid at his house. During raid, I left my vehicle in a certain distance and as per guidance of my source; I reached near the house of Sahadeb Mal. Seeing us in Police uniform, some people who gathered in front of their shop and the above noted accused peron flew away from there. Thereafter, I thoroughly searched the P.O. i.e. house of Sahadeb Mal with the help of my accompanying force after arranging sufficient torch light. Accordingly, we held raid and found the following articles into his house (1) Five white colour plastic jarriken containing 10 liters each which smells like I.D liquor, (Total value of seized articles Rs- 25,000/- approx.); (2) One bottle containing approx. 350 ml of colourless liquor which smells like ID liquor collected as sample from articles noted in Sl. No- (1). (3) The materials and the utensils by which the id liquor was making. On being asked the available people failed to give any satisfactory answer about the selling liquors. None came to sign in the seizure list so, I have seized the above noted articles duly signed by the accompanied Police persons in between 19:15 hrs to 19:25 hrs. During enquiry, it is learnt that Sahadeb Mal had stocked the id liquor with a view to sale the same to the local customers in high price without any permission from concerned authority to his wrongful gain which falls under the offence mention in Bengal Excise Act. Accordingly, I brought the seized articles to PS along with the following seized articles: - —(1) Five white plastic jarriken containing 10 liters each which smells like I.D liquor, (Total value of seized articles Rs- 25,000/- approx.); (2) One bottle containing approx. 350 ml of colourless liquor which smells like ID liquor collected as sample from seized articles noted in Sl. No- (1). (3) The materials and the utensils by which the id liquor was making.

I, therefore, pray before you that a specific case may kindly be started under proper section of law against the absconding accused person namely Sahadeb Mal (Age-35 Yrs), S/o-Fatik Mal of Vill-Kurpa (Malpara), PO-Gunnath, P.S- Indpur, Dist- Bankura and arrange for its investigation.
