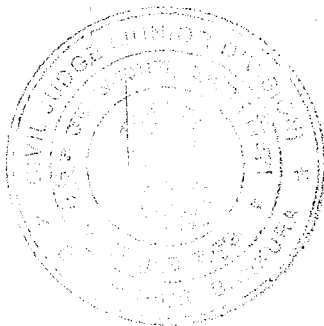

Record is put up at the instance of put up petition filed by plaintiff on this day.

One petition filed by plaintiff praying for ad-interim injunction under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 read with Section 151 CPC 05.01.23.

Ld. Advocate for the plaintiff submits that let the prayer for the ad-interim injunction be disposed of on this day.

As such ad-interim application is moved by Ld. Advocate of the plaintiff. Perused the instant application.

The record shows that the suit plots are not yet partitioned by metes and bounds amongst the plaintiff and defendants. In spite of that, defendant nos. 3 to 5 in connivance with each other are trying to change the nature and character some of the suit properties by making various sorts of illegal acts and activities thereon and they are also taking preparation for construction over the best and valuable portion of the suit properties forcibly. They are also planning to sell the valuable suit plots to some third persons, illegally and forcibly. The defendant nos. 3 to 5 also collected building materials thereon. Knowing the same, plaintiff tried to resist them, but they did not pay any heed to that and are threatening him in dire consequences. It is also stated by plaintiff that defendants are influential persons in the locality and they have muscle power and taking such advantage with an oblique motive, defendants are doing such type of illegal acts and activities over the suit property.

The plaintiff has been able to prove the prima-facie case by producing relevant documents in support of the instant application.

Perused the documents and this court finds it most important to preserve the nature and character of the suit property.

For that it is found expedient that the plaintiff and the defendant nos. 3 to 5 should be directed to maintain *status quo* in respect of scheduled suit property till the hearing of the temporary injunction.

Hence, it is,

ORDERED

that the plaintiff and defendant nos. 3 to 5 are hereby directed not change the nature and character of the schedule suit property till 21.01.2023.

Both the parties to this suit are hereby directed to maintain *status quo* in respect of the schedule suit property.

Issue notice upon defendant nos. 3 to 5 to show cause within 15 days from the date of receipt of notice as to why the prayer for temporary injunction shall not be granted as prayed for by plaintiff.

Plaintiff is to comply with the provisions of order 39 rule 3 (a) and (b) CPC within 24 hours failing which the order shall be recalled.

Plaintiff to file requisites forthwith.

In terms of the said notification of the Hon'ble High Court, Calcutta, and in terms of the recent verdict of the Hon'ble Apex Court, headed by Justice MR. Shah and Ahsanuddin Amanulla, that the the Lawyers cannot go on strike or abstain from work. In spite of the said verdict of the Apex Court, Ld. Lawyers have abstained themselves from work. So, the resolution dated 19.05.23 is not considered.

Moreover, cease work in this court is going on for more than one month and the poor litigant are coming and going, but not getting justice as the suffering of the litigant people is the paramount consideration of this court. So, the abstinence of the Ld. Advocates from work is not considered.

In terms of the above notification and decision of the Hon'ble Apex Court, defendant nos. 1, 3 to 6 are hereby directed to file a show cause as to why the suit shall not be proceeded ex-parte against them.

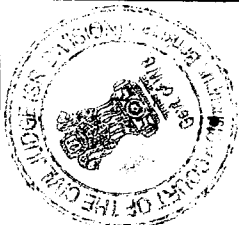
