Sub: Prayer for lodging FIR.

Sir,

In producing herewith the arrested accused person namely Sadhan Das (36 yrs) S/o-Sasanka Das of Vill-Banpur, PO-Basudebpur, PS-Sarenga, Dist-Bankura along with the following seized articles as (1) QUEEN(Royal Spirit) -20 bottles containing 300 ML each, value of Rs-20 X 30=600 under proper seizure list duly signed by him and other witnesses. I, ASI Nihar Sanigrahi of Sarenga P.S do here by lodged a complaint against him. I beg to state that, on 16.02.2024 at 21:15 hrs in course of special mobile duty received a credible source information that, at Banpur village More under Chiltore GP one person is selling country spirit illegally to the customers in exchange of money. Accordingly I informed the matter to I/C Sarenga PS and as per direction of I.C. Sarenga P.S. myself along with C/411 Jagannath Mandi (2) HG/41 Bholanath Masanta left for Banpur village More to work out the information, this refers to Sarenga PS GDE No-763 Dated-16.02.2024 & CC No-602/24 Dated-16.02.2024 myself along with force arrived at Banpur village More and kept our Govt. vehicle at a reasonable distance, moved towards the Tea Shop as shown by the source. We surrounded the room and found one person is selling country spirit to the customers, seeing the police party the persons who were consuming liquor managed to flee away but we apprehended one person who is selling country spirit. We searched the Tea Shop thoroughly and found the aforesaid articles. I asked him regarding any valid document or license for stocking such country spirit and selling the same to the customers but he failed to produce any valid documents in this respect. Accordingly I seized the same under proper seizure list and labeled duly signed by him and other witnesses. On interrogation he disclosed his identity Sadhan Das (36 yrs) S/o-Sasanka Das of Vill-Banpur, PO-Basudebpur, PS-Sarenga, Dist-Bankura. As he possessed and selling country spirit by violating the provision of Bengal Excise Act, hence I arrested the aforesaid person after maintaining all legal formalities regarding arrest.

Under the above circumstances, I pray a case may kindly be registered against him under proper section of law, as he possessed and selling country spirit by violating the provision of Bengal Excise Act.
