Respected Sir,

In producing here with seized article i.e 01 (one) white colour plastic Jar containing approx 10 Liters of I.D liquor and Sample bottle from the same. I write to inform you that today (26.02.24) in course of my Evening mobile duty at about 17:15 hrs I received secret source information from my reliable source that one person namely Lakshmi Bagdi, D/o- Tarapada Maji of Bishnupur Station Road, Bagdipara, PS- Bishnupur, Dist- Bankura was selling I.D liquor from her house. Accordingly, I informed I/C Bishnupur PS and as per his direction and being accompanied by my team C/955 Ashis Bokshi and C/271 Lalmohan Mahato of Bishnupur PS vide C.C No. 605/24, Dt. 26.02.24 left for Bishnupur Station Road, Bagdi para.

On 26.02.2024 at about 17:30 hrs, I along with force reached at the said house. I left my vehicle at a certain distance. We entered the house and found that seeing Police, some persons who were taking and selling liquor in the house started to flee away. We chased them but all of them somehow managed to escape.


I along with force searched the house in between 17:35hrs and 17:55hrs, seized 01 (one) white colour plastic Jar containing approx 10 Liters of I.D liquor and took sample in a bottle from the same from inside the house of Lakshmi Bagdi, D/o- Tarapada Maji of Bishnupur Station Road, Bagdipara, PS- Bishnupur, Dist- Bankura after preparing proper seizure list duly signed by the witnesses. On demand, no one came forward in favor of seized items and failed to produce any license or any valid document in favor of selling I.D liquor. On local enquiry, I came to learn that the name of the owner of the house is Lakshmi Bagdi, D/o- Tarapada Maji of Bishnupur Station Road, Bagdipara, PS- Bishnupur, Dist- Bankura & she is running this illegal business since long. However, in course of local inquiry the owner of the house is needed to be verified. Being asked the local witnesses who were present there refused to sign in seizure list and labels. Finding no other alternative, I took signature of my accompanying force as seizure witness. I could not arrest her as I did not have any lady Police with me and I contact the Police Station to get the lady Police, then she absconded from her house to avoid Police arrest.

Under the above fact and circumstance, I request you to start a specific case against the said accused namely Lakshmi Bagdi, D/o- Tarapada Maji of Bishnupur Station Road, Bagdipara, PS- Bishnupur, Dist- Bankura under proper section of law and arrange for its investigation.
