Sir,

I, Sri Goutam Goswami, Chairman of Bishnupur Municipality, am writing to inform you that the house-to-house drinking water connection work is currently underway across the entire municipal area as part of the "AMRUT 2.0" initiative.

This incident occurred today, March 1, 2024, at approximately 1:30 p.m. The agency (S.S.T. Engineering, P.O. & P.S. Suatahata, Dist. Purba Medinipur Pin-721635) was carrying out the installation of house-to-house water connections in Bhunearbari, within Ward No. 07, specifically at the residences of Rabial Mir, Lukman Mir, and Samaran Bibi. However, Smt. Jamila Bibi and her four daughters, including one daughter-in-law (Amirul Sekh), and four grandsons named Akash Choudhari, Islam Sekh, Yasin Sekh, ~~he~~ ~~he~~, objected to the work and physically assaulted both municipal staff (Sri Ganesh Paul and Sekh Rahim Dalal) and agency staff, using abusive language.

Following the use of provocative language and physical aggression with an iron rod and wooden stick, my staff managed to restrain them. Unfortunately, I also faced verbal abuse from Jamila Bibi at my office premises several times.

I must bring to your attention that a similar attempt was made by my team on February 21, 2024, and faced identical resistance.

Under the circumstances, it is crucial to take appropriate legal action against all accused persons in accordance with the provisions of the law.
