Respected Sir,

In producing here with seized articles (i) one old Bi-cycle having carrier and (ii) One (01) white colour plastic Jar containing approx 20 litre colorless liquor from which strong smell of I.D liquor is coming out (approx. value of Rs. 850/-) and one bottle containing approx. 350 ml of colorless ID liquor having strong smell of I.D liquor collected as sample from the above noted Jar duly sealed and labeled by me. I, P.S.I. Akash Patra of Bishnupur P.S do here by lodge complaint against one Lakhi Kanta Lohar (21 Yrs), S/O- Ajit Lohar of Hatgara, Belsulia, PS-Bishnupur, Dist-Bankura to the effect that while performing special mobile as well as naka checking vide Bishnupur PS GDE No 407 dt 07.03.24 at Mishrisole Naka point under Bishnupur PS with the team of Bishnupur. At the Mishrisole Naka point we checked different vehicles, motorcycles and cycles. At about 18.05 hrs we noticed one man was coming from Gorbetta side riding with bi cycle loaded with one plastic bag contained a jar. Then myself along with force started to search his bag in his presence. During search we found some ID liquor from which strong smell of ID liquor is coming out. On being asked the said person neither gave any satisfactory answer for carrying ID liquor on his bag nor able to produce any valid licence in respect of the ID liquor. I asked his identity but he refused to disclose his name and address after several times. During interrogation; he confessed that he has been selling ID from last 6 months without any valid license under the different places of Bishnupur PS. There after I seized the ID liquor and his bi cycle. Labeling was done properly on the jar of id liquor. During preparation of seizure list several local witnesses were asked to sign on the seizure list but no one appeared. Finding no other alternative I took signature of accompanying team of Bishnupur PS as seizure witness. The above noted person namely Lakhi Kanta Lohar (21 Yrs), S/O- Ajit Lohar of Hatgara, Belsulia, PS-Bishnupur, Dist-Bankura has committed an offence under Bengal Excise Act which is cognizable in nature and he was committing this offence in presence of police officer. So I arrested him after maintaining all the guidelines of the apex court. I informed his relatives about the arrest and also explained the arrested accused and his family members the grounds of arrest.

The description of the seized articles is given below:

- i) One (01) white colour plastic Jar containing approx 20 litre colorless ID liquor.
- ii) One old Bi-cycle having carrier.

Under the above circumstances I pray that a specific case may kindly be registered against the arrested person for violation of Bengal Excise Rule against Lakhi Kanta Lohar (21 Yrs), S/O- Ajit Lohar of Hatgara, Belsulia, PS-Bishnupur, Dist-Bankura and arranged for its investigation.
