Sub: - Prayer for lodging FIR.

Respected Madam,

With due regards, I SI Ayen Chandra Mahato of Hirbandh PS, Bankura beg to report that today on 14/03/24 in course of my RT mobile duty vide Hirbandh PS GDE No- 543 Date-14.03.24 & CC NO- 658/24, DT.14.03.2024 received information over mobile phone from SI Ansuman Pati, Table duty officer of Hirbandh PS to the effect that the table duty officer received on information over mobile phone that a lot of people gathered on SH-02 near Baharamuri bridge under Hirbandh PS and obstructed from SH-02 (Indpur-Khatra State High way) with a view to hackle people and movement of vehicles on various demand. After receiving this information, I immediately informed this to O/C Hirbandh PS and as per direction of O/C Hirbandh PS I along with my accompanied forces namely C/380 Kushal Ch Gope Maji, C/619 Bikash Mondal, NVF-252 Sk Sarwar Hossain, LC/1530 Purnima Hansda (Murmu) rushed to the spot to work out the said information. When we reached to the spot found that about 30-40 local people obstructed started from 08:45hrs on SH-02 road (Indpur-Khatra state highway) and both side traffic were totally stopped & jammed. They also threatened and using slang languages to the drivers of the vehicles to remain stay there. They obstructed the traffic movement and public movement without any intimation/permission from any concerned authorities. We tried to convince those people who obstructed the road to take shelter before appropriate authority as per law and to leave the road as the traffic became stopped and created inconvenience to those people who use this road for their movement and transportation from one place to another. But unfortunately they did not pay any heed to our words. Rather they formed an unlawful assembly and continued such activities. I asked them to clear the road again and again but all of them disobey the order of on duty police and other peoples who requested those people to pass them. The consequences of their such act, police dispersed them and the road blockade was withdraw at about 12:05 hrs. From local & source information some persons were identified who lead the unlawful assemble such as 1) Krishnapada Gope (33yrs) S/O- Chandi Gope 2) Umapada Gope (37yrs) S/O- Manoranjan Gope 3) Bidyut Gope (30yrs) S/O- Prabhas Gope 4) Bikash Gope (0yrs) S/O- Shankar Gope 5) Bidyadhar Gope (36yrs) S/O-Karali Gope 6) Rajib Gope (28yrs) S/O- Bhakta Gope, 7) Bapi Ghosh (30Yrs), S/O- Naran Ghosh all of Shyampur village, PS-Hirbandh, Dist-Bankura and other persons were with them.

Hence the above noted accused persons are notorious mob in the area, obstructed started from 08:45hrs and ended 12:05hrs on road SH 02, obstructed police personals for performing Govt duty and deter in discharge to obey the order of on duty police officials. So I do hereby lodge this complaint for starting a specific case against all the accused persons as noted above and others who were with the identified persons and pray for its investigation.
