Sub:- Prayer for lodging a F.I.R against arrested accused person namely Rajen Bagdi (approx 22 years), S/o- Ram Bagdi of vill- Dhamur, PS- Indas, Dist- Bankura.

Respected Sir,

In producing herewith arrested accused person namely Rajen Bagdi (approx 22 years), S/o- Ram Bagdi of vill- Dhamur, PS- Indas, Dist- Bankura with seized colourless liquor amounting about 10 liters in a plastic jariken from which strong smell of I.D liquor is coming out and one bottle containing approx 350 ml of colourless liquor having strong smell of I.D liquor collected as sample from the above noted plastic jariken under proper seizure list and label. I beg to report that today i.e. on 23.03.24 while myself along with force were engaged in mobile duty in P.S area at about 19.55 hrs, received secret source information that one person namely Rajen Bagdi is stocking I.D liquor for selling at Dhamur village. I informed the matter to O/C Indas PS immediately over phone and as per his verbal direction, myself along with force rushed to that spot and met with my source there. As guided by my source, keeping our vehicle in a certain distance, I along with force reached at Dhamur village near the house of Rajen Bagdi and apprehended the accused person. On interrogation, he disclosed his identity as noted above and also confessed that he has been selling I.D liquor at Dhamur village since long. I verbally offered him for search. Thereafter, as shown by him I found one Plastic Jariken, containing approx 10 (Ten) litres ID liquor (Chullu) from his house which was kept under cot in his bed room. In presence of the accused person and my accompanying force, I opened the cap of the plastic jariken to check and found approx 10 liters of colourless liquor having strong smell of I.D liquor inside of the plastic jariken. On being asked he could produce neither any license nor any valid document in respect of the said liquor or his business of liquor. Accordingly, I seized the above noted plastic jariken as shown and identified by the accused person from his house at village Dhamur and one bottle containing approx. 350 ml of colourless liquor having strong smell of I.D liquor collected as sample from the above noted plastic jariken under proper seizure list in-between 20:35 hrs to 20:55 hrs and also prepared its label. I requested the local available witnesses who gathered on the spot to sign in the seizure list as seizure witness but no one came forward. Finding no other alternative, I took signature of my accompanying force as seizure witnesses. After reading it over to the accused person in his own language, I obtained his signature on the seizure list and label and also supplied a copy to him. Thereafter, maintaining all legal formalities as directed by the Honorable Apex Court and N.H.R.C, I arrested him under proper Memo of Arrest and brought him to PS along with seized articles.
