Sub: - Prayer for lodging of F.I.R against arrested person namely Shiba Prasad Kundu (Age-45 Years) approx.), S/o-Late Krishnapada Kundu of Vill- Boga, PS- Indpur, Dist- Bankura.

Respected Sir,

In producing herewith one arrested accused person namely Shiba Prasad Kundu (Age-45 Years) approx.), S/o-Late Krishnapada Kundu of Vill- Boga, PS- Indpur, Dist- Bankura along with seized articles i.e. 20 litres (approx.) colourless liquor in two white plastic jarriken containing 10 liters each which smells like I.D liquor, (Total value of seized articles Rs- 4400/- approx.) under proper seizure list duly signed by witnesses and submitting a complaint against the aforesaid accused person to the effect that today i.e on 03.04.2024 at about 06:05 hrs, in course of PS mobile duty vide Indpur P.S C.C No- 584/24 and GDE No- 55 both dated-02.04.2024 received a secret source information that sell of I.D liquor is going on in the house of Shiba Prasad Kundu of Vill- Boga, PS- Indpur, Dist- Bankura. Accordingly, I informed the matter to OC Indpur P.S and as per his kind direction, myself along with C/712- Susanta Chakraborty, C/416- Swpan Santra & HG-BKL/03- Bapi Mahata all of Indpur PS held raid in the said house. During raid, I left my vehicle in a certain distance and as per guidance of my source; I reached near the house of Shiba Prasad Kundu. Seeing us in Police uniform, some people who gathered in front of his house, started to flee away. However, after a short chase, myself with the help of my accompanying force, somehow managed to apprehend one person. On being asked, he disclosed his identity as noted above. Accordingly, we held raid in his house and found the above noted articles in his house. On being asked, he failed to give any satisfactory answer and also failed to produce any license or valid documents for selling liquors from his house. Accordingly, I seized the above noted articles from the possession of above noted accused person under proper seizure list and prepared sample & label duly signed by the accused person and witnesses in-between 06:55 hrs to 07:15 hrs, instead of several requests, none could agree to sign in the seizure list as witness. As such, finding no other alternatives, I seized the same as per proper seizure list duly signed by Police witness as well as accused person. On interrogation, the accused confessed that he had stocked plastic jarikens loaded with I/D liquor with a view to sale the same to the local customers in high price without any permission from concerned authority for his wrongful gain which attracts the offence mention in Bengal Excise Act. Accordingly, I arrested him under Memo of Arrest after maintaining all the legal formalities and brought him to PS along with the following seized articles: - (1) two plastic jerricans containing approx. 10 litres each of colourless liquor which smells like ID liquor; (2) One bottle containing approx. 350 ml of colourless liquor which smells like ID liquor collected as sample from seized articles noted in Sl. No- (1).

I, therefore, pray before you that a specific case may kindly be started under proper section of law against accused Shiba Prasad Kundu (Age-45 Years) approx.), S/o-Late Krishnapada Kundu of Vill- Boga, PS- Indpur, Dist- Bankura and arrange for its investigation.
