Sub: - Prayer for starting a specific case.

Sir,

In producing here with two arrested accused persons namely (1) Chiranjit Bauri, S/o- Paran Bauri of Vill- Jenari, PS- Gangajal Ghati, Dist-Bankura (2) Bidhan Bauri, S/o- Dhiren Bauri of Vill- Damodarpur, PS- Saltora, Dist- Bankura under arrest and seized two stone chips loaded vehicles (Dumper) having Registration No: - WB81/1263 & WB81/2463 under seizure list enclosed here with.

I do here by lodge this complaint regarding that today i.e on 21.06.2024 at about 16:25 hrs during my mobile duty vide Indpur PS C.C. No- 742/24 and GDE No- 485 both dated-21.06.2024 at Bagdiha Naka Post under Indpur PS received a credible source information about two stone chips loaded vehicles (Dumper) were coming from Bankura side towards Khatra through Bankura-Khatra Road (SH-02) without valid challan. Immediately, I detained both the vehicles for checking. On demand the drivers of those vehicles unable to produce any proper chalan regarding loaded stone chips on their vehicles. On interrogation the drivers of above noted vehicles were stated that they stole the stone chips from Saltora mining under Saltora PS to dispose it clandestinely for illegal gain. I informed the matter to OC Indpur PS and as per his kind instruction. I have seized those above noted vehicles (Dumper) having registration No: - WB81/1263 loaded with stone chips in between 17:15 hrs to 17:55 hrs & Vehicle (Dumper) having registration No- WB81/2463 loaded with stone chips in between 18:05 hrs to 18:25 hrs on 21.06.2024 under proper seizure list duly signed by the witnesses. Then arrested the accused drivers after maintaining the all-legal formalities as prescribed by apex court and NHRC guideline. Thereafter, I brought those arrested accused drivers along with seized vehicles to Indpur PS and submitted a complaint as suo-moto to this PS.

Under the above fact on study of circumstances it is evidently established that the above noted accused persons have virtually committed offence which is punishable U/S- 379/411 I.P.C and Section 21 of Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957.
